Discover the Keys to Staying Full of God



Do you ever feel like you and God have drifted apart and that the love and joy you once experienced with Him has faded? If you do, you're not alone. **Most Christians feel like the experiences they have with God diminish over time** and that they need another touch. But that is not what the Bible teaches.

The Bible says God will never leave us nor forsake us (Heb. 13:5). If that is true - and it is - who moved? As born-again believers, we are all capable of living in the fullness of God every day of our lives. God is continually pouring out His love, joy, peace, revelation knowledge, and every other blessing.

But we can get to a point where we're not receiving and feel like He has drifted away.

Romans 1:21 says,

When they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

This scripture contains four separate elements, or keys, that can lead us into and keep us operating in the fullness of God. Expressed positively, they are:

- Glorify God
- Be thankful
- Recognise the power of imagination
- Have a good heart

We have the power to control each of these in our lives.

The first key - to glorify God - has a lot to do with how we perceive Him.

In many places throughout the Bible, the word *magnify* is the same word that is translated as *glorify*. Therefore, *magnify* and *glorify* can be used

interchangeably. And *magnify* means to make bigger. Technically speaking, God is who He is, regardless of what you think, but in terms of your perception, He can be big or small. You have the power to make Him one or the other in your life.

Most of us have become masters at enlarging the problem and minimising God and His Word. I remember a lady who thought she was pregnant but found out she had cancer instead. The doctors said she needed a hysterectomy immediately. They said she only had a 50 percent chance of living, and she wouldn't live more than two weeks without surgery.

She came to me, crying, "Andrew, have you heard what they said?" Now, I don't always respond this way, but I believe God led me to say what I did. I started laughing and declared, "Cancer's no problem with God. The lights in heaven won't dim from the power drain if the Lord heals you! It's not any harder to be healed of cancer than it is to be healed of a cold."



I started magnifying and glorifying God. **I made the Lord bigger and the cancer smaller.** The only thing that made the cancer insurmountable was the value she was placing on what the doctors said. They even called her a fool for refusing treatment and made her sign paperwork to absolve them of liability "when" she died. But she decided to stand her ground and believe God. It's now been almost twenty years since she refused that operation, and she has a whole slew of children.

What do you value? What's big to you? **You can magnify the Lord and make Him and His Word bigger than any problem.** Do it by glorifying, praising, and thanking Him. Find someone in the Word who overcame a situation similar to yours. Meditate on the Word and make it more real to you than the problem. You need to get to a place where God's Word is true to you and where He is greater than any situation. Remember, Mark 9:23 tells us, "*All things are possible to him that believeth.*"

I don't have the space here to get into all the other keys, but I want to touch on them. **The second key to staying full of God is a thankful heart.** Paul listed unthankfulness as one of the signs of the end times and put it in the same verse as covetousness, pride, blasphemy, and unholiness (2 Tim. 3:1-2). Glorifying, magnifying, and thanking Him are all interrelated, but to glorify God, you must be thankful. As you are thanking Him, you're reminding yourself of what He has said and done, which magnifies Him.

Every time you are tempted to gripe and complain about a problem, don't. Instead, enter into God's presence and spend ten minutes thanking Him for His goodness. If you do, you'll find that the natural desire to complain will cease, and the problem will shrink as you begin to see it in the proper perspective.

The third key is imagination. Imagination is much more important than most of us realise. Those of us with vain imaginations are pessimists, imagining failure instead of success. We need to use our imaginations to agree with God's Word and see ourselves the way God sees us: happy, healthy, and prosperous.

The fourth key is to have a good heart. The Scripture makes it very clear that the attitude of your heart is far more important than your actions. Our hearts control what we say, and they also control what we do. Love, joy, peace, patience, and the rest of the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23) are products of what our hearts believe. The reason the heart responds in a negative way is because we allow it to

be dominated by external or physical things instead of by the Word of God.

If you will put these four keys into practice in your life, you will never be the same. It will change the way you think about everyone and everything around you. I've only discussed the tip of the iceberg on these four keys, so I hope you'll get the full teaching. 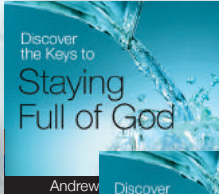

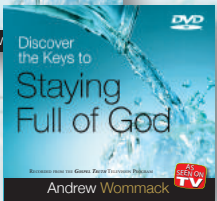

A picture is worth a thousand words, and a vision from God can direct us so much more than a word from Him. As we hear from God, we can see in our hearts what He has planned for us. How do you see yourself? How do you see your life, your situation, and your future? How do you see your ministry or your calling? All of these things are affected by your outlook.

How we see ourselves may be affected by other people's opinions or how we believe they see us. We can see ourselves through our past and all of the things we've walked through. We can see ourselves through what is currently happening in our lives. Both the blessings in our lives and the obstacles are shaped by how we see ourselves.

Proverbs 23:7 says, *"For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he."*

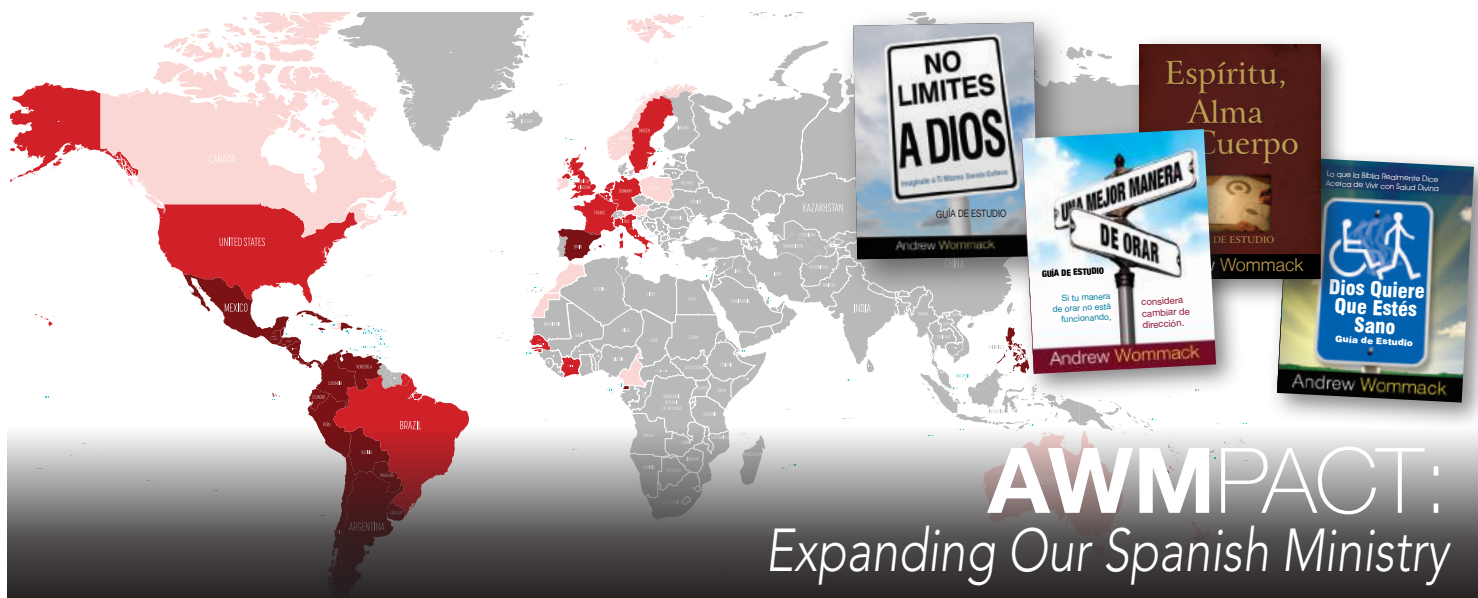
Many limitations we have in life are self-imposed. The devil has no power over us, and God is for us, not against us. God has already said yes and amen (2 Cor. 1:20). If that's all true, then the only factor is us. We need to recognise how we impose limits on ourselves and that our small thinking limits what God can do in our lives. Whatever the obstacles

in front of you, God has given you the ability to see beyond them and to not be confined by those temporary things.

You can't afford to miss seeing yourself as God sees you. Whatever you see becomes a self-fulfilling prophecy. Problems in life really reveal a problem in vision. Without His perspective, things can appear discouraging and meaningless. With His perspective, everything appears differently.

The things we see in Jesus' life, He first saw them in His heart. The way Jesus lived His life is the same way we are to live our lives. We can use Jesus' life as a pattern to get the same results He did. God thinks so much higher than we do. As heaven is so much higher than the earth, God's thoughts are so much higher than our own (Is. 55:9).

To believe in God is to believe in yourself because you come from Him. Don't be led from the outside in by the thoughts and opinions of the world, but rather, allow God to lead you from the inside out. God is saying, "I don't want to lead you by outward circumstances." Instead, He will teach and instruct you in the way to go (Ps. 32:8). And how will He do it? He will do it by guiding you with His eye (Ps. 32:8).

That is why we are incredibly excited about one of our largest and most important projects of 2022 - the launch of AWM en Español. The goal of AWM en Español is to replicate the AWM experience for a Spanish-speaking audience and includes the launch of *The Gospel Truth* program on Enlace TV and the launch of **awmi.net/espanol**, our new Spanish website.

According to Enrique de la Vega, our Spanish ministry manager, most born-again Hispanic believers are first generation, and many are bound with tradition, superstition, witchcraft, and other bondages. He says, "In their newfound faith, they are hungry for the truth - and they are eager to share the truths that help them in their walk with God." Our aim is to make the truth accessible to them in as many ways as possible.

One way we are accomplishing this is through the translation of Andrew's books. Throughout the past fourteen years, our Spanish translator Citlalli Macy has been translating Andrew's

books and study guides into Spanish. To date, she has translated twenty-seven books and fourteen study guides.

We also have a busy AWM office and Charis location in Mexico, led by César del Angel, our AWM México Director. César and his team have been instrumental in supporting the U.S. office with this AWM en Español endeavour, including through Spanish translation and voice-over work for *The Gospel Truth*. They have also started a call centre with phone ministers who are ready to support callers by providing prayer, products, Charis enrollment information, and partnership assistance. Andrew's primary Helpline in the U.S. has also expanded to include more Spanish-speaking phone ministers who can be reached at **719-635-1111**.

We welcome you to watch *The Gospel Truth* program Monday through Friday on Enlace TV. And we also encourage you to visit **awmi.net/espanol** to explore our new website and find an ever-growing number of resources in Spanish. Thank you, partners, for helping us better reach our Spanish-speaking brothers and sisters. Because of you, countless people are receiving the deep discipleship of the true Gospel message in their own mother tongue, and their lives are being transformed!
