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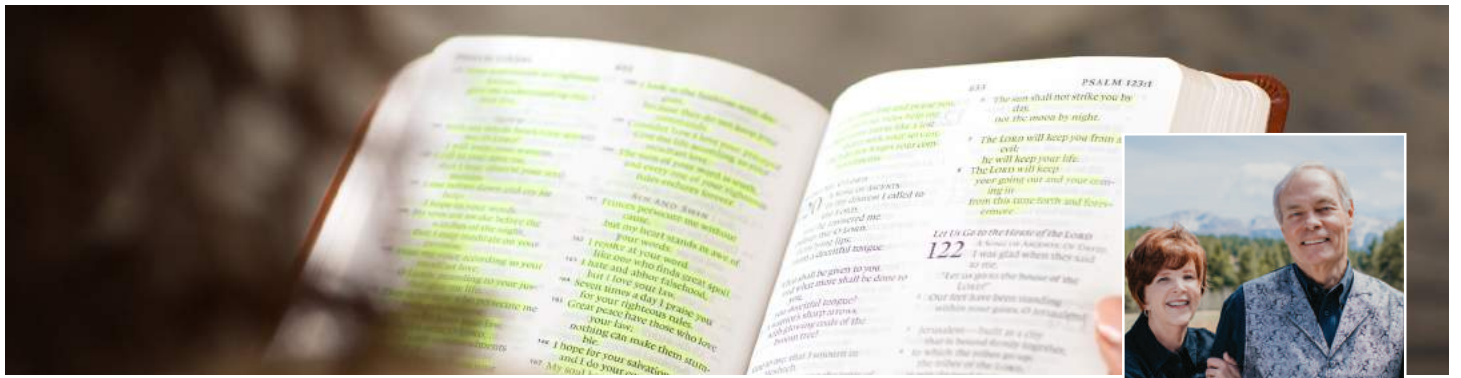
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A Better Way to Pray

I think prayer is probably one of the most abused and misused things in the Christian life.

We are seeing attacks on the church, the family, and children like nothing we've ever seen in the history of the United States. When fear sets in, some people go to panicking, while others start praying and asking God for revival.

But many of the prayers I've been hearing are not done in the most effective way. I'm not trying to criticise people, but they are praying out of desperation; they're praying out of fear. They aren't taking their authority and using it. The majority of people believe that just as long as they pray, everything is fine. That is not true. **There is a right way and a wrong way to pray.**

Look at what Jesus said when He talked about prayer in Matthew 6, often called the Sermon on the Mount:

And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

Matthew 6:5, emphasis mine

Jesus felt it was important enough to teach His disciples **what not to do** when praying. **Prayer is not an opportunity to inform "poor misinformed God" of how bad your situation is.** It seems like people think they've got to get their request to the top of the pile because God just has so many people asking Him for things. In Matthew 6, Jesus goes on to say,

Be not ye therefore like unto them [heathens]: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

Matthew 6:8, brackets added

A lot of what people are doing today is nothing but praying out of fear. They think that if they start with "our heavenly Father," end with "in the name of Jesus," and say whatever they want in between, they've said a prayer. No—that's not how prayer works. People are praying with a whole lot of unbelief and a whole lot of fear. But according to Psalm 91:5, we don't have to be afraid of the terror by night (that means the deadly plague). Psalm 91:10 goes on to say that no evil will befall us, and no plague will come near our dwelling.

I tell you, there is a right way and a wrong way to pray, and a lot of people are not praying the right way. For example, people may tell God they're fearful and depressed and ask Him to give them joy, peace, and protection. But Psalm 91:1 says,

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

And Psalm 16:11 says,

Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

So if you aren't experiencing peace, protection, fullness of joy, and pleasures forevermore, it's because you aren't staying in the presence of God. **God is always with you, but you aren't always appropriating what He's provided.**

A key to prayer is that all of God's promises about protection have to be spoken (Ps. 91:2). You also have to believe He has given you His power. So instead of asking God to do something about the coronavirus, you need to believe **He has given you power over all sickness and over all disease** (Matt. 10:1 and

8), and then you start speaking to it. There are millions of people around the world who are praying and asking for God's help, but they don't understand God has already given it.

When I was just getting started fifty-five years ago, I would see a few miracles happen every once in a while. I would sometimes see the presence and the power of God show up, and I'd see some of my prayers answered. (You know, even an old, blind squirrel will get a nut every once in a while.) **But they were few and far between because I was praying the way that is traditionally taught.** Yet God loved me, and I loved Him.

But over these years of seeking the Lord, **I've learned some things. I've learned a better way to pray, and I get better results today than I have ever gotten.** I believe my prayer life and my relationship with the Lord is better than it's ever been.

There's so much more to it than space will allow here. So I've put what I've learned into my teaching called *A Better Way to Pray*. This teaching has set many people free, including my friend John Tesh. He was given eighteen months to live in 2015, and he took hold of Mark 11:23 and began speaking to his mountain. John still stands on this scripture in 2023. I've had so many people tell me that this knowledge revolutionised their relationship with the Lord. They've said it's one of the most important things they've ever learned.

With all that is happening in our world today, you need to be praying the right way.

And as these truths set you free, I pray that the Lord will grant you opportunities to share these things with others so they can also begin experiencing a better way to pray!

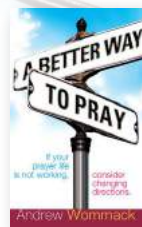

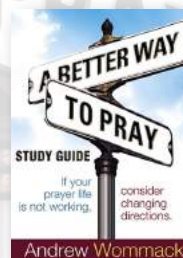

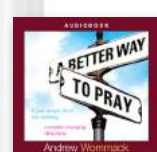

How Important Is a Biblical Worldview?

Do you know biblical truths about societal issues but feel ill-equipped to defend them? Whether from fear or a lack of knowledge, many Christians keep quiet when God's Word is challenged. Others have been deceived after becoming entangled in the world's philosophies and depravities.

Our worldview is the filter through which we process life. As Christians, it should be based on the uncompromised Word of God—not on popular culture.

During World War II, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a German clergyman, moved to the United States. But he felt he owed it to his fellow German citizens to go back to Germany and engage in the battle against Hitler's agenda.

Although his brave return to Germany led to his imprisonment and ultimate death sentence, Dietrich Bonhoeffer went to his execution glorifying God. And instead of showing grief and sorrow in the face of this unjust act, he rejoiced. Why? Because he had a biblical worldview!

Bonhoeffer's faith in Christ gave him the courage and confidence to stand against the greatest evil of the twentieth century. As a result, he went out with a shout, trusting God, speaking his faith, and looking forward to what would come after death. In contrast, Hitler did not have a biblical worldview, and he ended up committing suicide that same year.

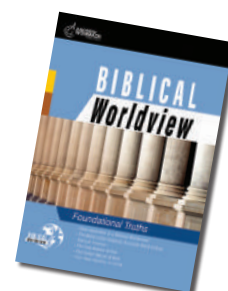
Here are some foundational truths that people with a biblical worldview believe:

- Absolute moral truth exists.
- The Bible is not just a book written by men but a book that God inspired men to write.

- The Bible is totally accurate in all the principles it teaches.
- Satan is not just an idea, a concept, or a personification of evil; he is a real being.
- No one can earn their way into heaven; they must have faith in what Jesus did for them.
- Jesus Christ lived a sinless life on earth.
- God is the all-knowing, all-powerful Creator of the world who still rules the universe today.

The Bible warns us to *"be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour"* (1 Pet. 5:8). That's why it's crucial to have a biblical worldview. It equips you for victory by strengthening your faith and giving you a firm foundation on which to stand. You won't be caught off guard by Satan and his schemes when you commit to understanding God's Word and make it the source of your worldview.

In today's society, it's more important than ever to have the right lens through which to view things—the right worldview. The right worldview is based on the Bible! Wealth and business building are about giving, not getting. When I say give, I'm not talking about church offerings or charity donations (though I am including those). I'm talking about really making a difference. Because everyone has a purpose and can make a difference.

Understanding how we partner with God to make a difference is the biblical foundation of business. Before crossing into the Promised Land, Moses warned Israel not to take credit for their prosperity:

"Then you say in your heart, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.' And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day."

Deuteronomy 8:17–18, New King James Version

As I say in my book *Money Mastery*, an important thing to remember is that we're "making sense of making money, for making a difference."

The following five biblical principles—forming a biblical foundation for business—are from the first five books of the Old Testament (known as the Pentateuch), and they give us insight into the financial mindset of the Jewish people:

1. Participation in the Creative Process—Working together with God to do what He wants to do in the earth, the way Adam tended to the garden of Eden (Gen. 2:15).

2. Protection of Private Property—Giving people the opportunity to own property, resources, or assets (Gen 13:15, Ex. 6:8, Deut. 1:8, Is. 61:4).

3. The Accumulation of Wealth (a Virtue)—Honouring and finding virtue in partnering with God to accumulate wealth, not mistaking poverty as noble (Deut. 8:18, Ps. 90:17).

4. Caring for the Needy—Helping those in need, including both charitable giving and empowering the poor to come out of poverty on their own (Deut. 15:11, Matt. 26:11).

5. Limited Government—Allowing everyone to have the opportunity to prosper through limited government involvement and protection of private property.

I also like to connect the Hebrew concept known as *tikkun olam*, which means "repairing or perfecting the world," with the Lord's Prayer, "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10). In the end, it all comes down to building wealth with God so you can be an even greater blessing to others, not so you can use it for selfish purposes.

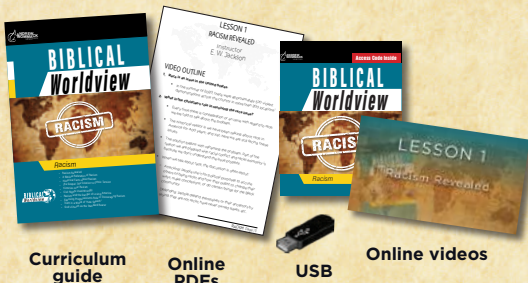
