God Wants You Well

All of us need to understand the healing power of God. We're living in a day and age in which man has politicised medicine. You can't depend on anything but Jesus, and you need to learn how to receive your healing directly from God.

I'm not saying I'm the perfect example on this, but it has been decades since I've been sick. I refuse to cooperate with sickness and disease. I've seen my son raised from the dead; I've seen blind eyes opened, deaf ears opened, and many other healings. I believe the things that God has taught me will work for you.

When it comes to health, one of the biggest misconceptions is that

God puts sickness on us as a way to punish us or teach us a lesson. I was raised in a denomination that taught that God uses sickness to humble you, to break you, or to punish you as judgment. I was taught that sickness was a positive thing. Today, I disagree with that 100 percent.

The truth is that sickness is of the devil. Sickness doesn't come from God. And if you ever waver on that point, you won't see healing.

Jesus is the express image of the Father (Heb. 1:3). He says whatever the Father does is what I do (John 5:19). Jesus never made anybody sick. He never told anybody, *You stay sick a little longer; you haven't learned your lesson.* He never punished anybody with sickness. As a matter of fact, Acts 10:38 says,

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

I won't deny that there are examples of God putting sickness on people in the Old Testament, but it was always a punishment. It was never a blessing. And we are no longer under the Old Covenant. Galatians 3:13 tells us, *"Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law."* **Under the New Covenant, God does not punish any of his children with sickness.**

Some of you don't have any confidence that God is going to heal you because you feel like you don't deserve it, or maybe you're supposed to learn something, or maybe this is punishment from God. Those thoughts will keep you from aggressively reaching out and taking your healing. You've got to get past that. You've got to know that healing is part of the atonement of the Lord Jesus. Did you know that the Greek word *sozo* is used over one hundred times in the New Testament, and it encompasses everything Jesus did for us? It applies to the forgiveness of our sins, and also to our healing, deliverance, and prosperity.

1 Peter 2:24 tells us:

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Notice that this one scripture combines the forgiveness of our sins and the healing of our bodies. God would no more want you to live in sickness than He wants you to live in sin. He has forgiven you of sin and healed you of sickness in the same way: through Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. Healing is part of the atonement of Jesus and it's wrong to separate what God did. If somebody brought me a bundle of gifts, and I looked at it and said, *I'm just going to take one gift, but all the rest of this, thank you, but no thanks* - this would not bless the person who gave me the gifts. **Jesus died to provide not only for our sins, but to provide healing of our bodies, and prosperity, and deliverance, and joy, and peace, and vision, and on and on you could go.**

But the modern-day church, for whatever reason, has basically said, *We should only accept forgiveness of sins, and it's only when we get to heaven that we will experience complete healing and joy and peace, but right now, all we can expect is just to get saved and stuck. We're just holding on until we get to heaven.* Jesus told us in Matthew 6:10 to pray, *"Thy will be done [on] earth, as it is in heaven."* Jesus told us to pray for God's will to be done here on earth as it is in heaven. Is there going to be sickness in heaven? No. We are supposed to expect to walk in healing now.

I'm not condemning anybody who's sick any more than I'm condemning any person who's living in sin. But I'm saying sickness is not God's will for you. And I love people enough to tell them that you need to make Jesus your Lord (John 3:3). I love you enough to tell you that God doesn't want you to be sick. That is not God's will for you. Jesus paid for your physical healing just as much as He paid for your forgiveness of sins.

Knowing that God's will is for you to be well is absolutely critical, but it is just the beginning of understanding healing. I encourage you to learn more about God's spiritual laws of healing, including the laws of faith and how God's power flows to you. I explain all this in my *God Wants You Well* teaching. Admiral Albert Kelln is a decorated war hero. Though his military life has been full of accomplishments, Al's greatest adventures in life didn't happen until decades later when he first heard Andrew Wommack's teaching.

Al served in the U.S. Navy for twenty-eight years and was awarded the Legion of Merit for his many accomplishments. After receiving a master's degree in nuclear physics, he served on the Navy's first nuclear attack submarine. Through his missions to the Arctic Ocean, he became the first man to fly over, stand on, and pass under the North Pole. He also survived deadly missions in the Korean War. His hard work, determination, and bravery in the line of duty earned him the rank of admiral. By the time he was in his seventies, it seemed like his best days were over. That was when his wife, Cecily, came across a cassette tape that would change their lives forever.

Cecily says, "We were going to a church that did not share the teaching of receiving the Holy Spirit. We went to a friend's home, and when we were leaving, she handed me this cassette tape. . . . We put it in, and this man [Andrew] was saying if you don't have the baptism in the Holy Spirit, you're

not really empowered to do the ministry that you should be doing."

After receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit, Al and Cecily were eager to learn more about their new identity and started watching Andrew's *Gospel Truth* program on a regular basis.

Little did they know that this foundation on their authority in Christ would be put to the ultimate test. At the age of seventy-six, Al was rushed to the hospital because of a gastrointestinal rupture. He flatlined, yet Cecily had faith for Al's healing. She felt the Holy Spirit's assurance that they had more ministry ahead of them.

Suddenly, Al's heart started beating again. Despite having flatlined for almost half an hour, Al came back to life.

The Holy Spirit didn't just raise Al from the dead; He energised the Kellns to spread the Gospel with others. Excited to share God's kingdom, they started food banks, nursing home ministries, and a thriving pregnancy centre. Now, at the age of ninety-one, Al's next mission is to reach military families and disciple them under the same teachings that have forever changed his life.

"You're never too old, because once you give the Holy Spirit permission to use you and to instruct you, things just fall into place. . . . He's got a lot for me to do, and it's a pleasure to be alive and to serve God," Al says.

Thank you, friends and partners. Because of you, a ninety-one-year-old admiral was able to overcome the spirit of death by the power of the Holy Spirit and is now starting ministries throughout Texas. Her artwork has been featured at Charis before, most notably in the parking garage where she and her daughter, Star, painted murals. When she was a first-year student, God gave her the opportunity to volunteer with our theatrical productions earlier than she had anticipated.

"I thought 'Wow! This is an amazing way to use artistic talents for the glory of God!'" Jeannie says. "I thought I'd have to be in third-year Creative Arts School (now the Film and Production School) in order to do this, but in the second week of our first year of school, the call went

out and I signed up, not knowing this would be the creation of *David* that I would get to be part of."

Jeannie uses her art as an avenue for spiritual growth. For her, it's about letting the Spirit lead.

One of her favourite props to work on was the marble pillars. "The marble pillars were really a turning point for me in how to yield to the Holy Spirit and let Him paint through my hand. I had never done anything like this and just held that brush and let Him guide everything."

Productions such as these share the stories of the Bible in a new light and allow the audience to experience God in a tangible way. "When I saw the things we made being used on stage for this production, I was overwhelmed at what God was doing with all of it. The props help to tell the story and become a part of the anointing this masterpiece has," Jeannie says. "I really feel that this is like when God told Moses that He had raised up Bezalel and other artisans to create the Tabernacle - it becomes a way of making the invisible visible, so the manifest presence of God can be experienced."

We are blessed to have artists like Jeannie to help bring the vision of this musical to life.

Maybe it all began with participation trophies.

A couple of decades ago, youth sports leagues in many communities began to disallow talk of winning or losing, and all players on *both* teams received a trophy simply for having played. Bestowing the so-called “participation trophy” became common throughout many childhood activities.

The unintended consequence has been *devalued* achievement. Hard work, sacrifice, dedication to a cause – these time-honoured virtues are not as prized as they once were.

And now, well into the twenty-first century, elected officials, educators, and celebrity pundits say that all people deserve free healthcare, guaranteed income, free college tuition (resulting in degrees received without pass or fail grading), and more. These unrealistic ideas have been pumped into the minds of several generations of Americans, and we now hear voices crying for such things as abolishment of law enforcement, which would only result in higher crime rates and instability throughout many cities. We’ve become a lawless people, restlessly demanding things to which we feel we are entitled.

Would the implementation of socialist policies and (ultimately) a Marxist government be compassionate to citizens? Consider two things that pro-socialist voices want: free college tuition and free healthcare. The math behind such socialist goals does not compute.

If our government taxed 100 percent of the earnings of the wealthiest Americans, even this would not wipe out the over 1.7 trillion student loan debt. What about Medicare? Every penny the wealthiest Americans will make over the next twelve months wouldn’t keep Medicare going for even three years. Nothing is left to fund a “guaranteed basic income for all” and the other seemingly endless government

programs that socialists demand *must* be started.

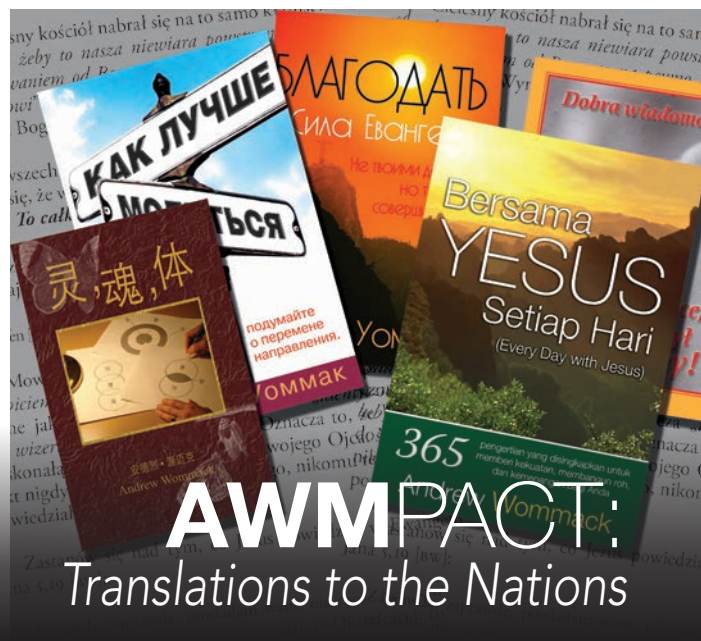
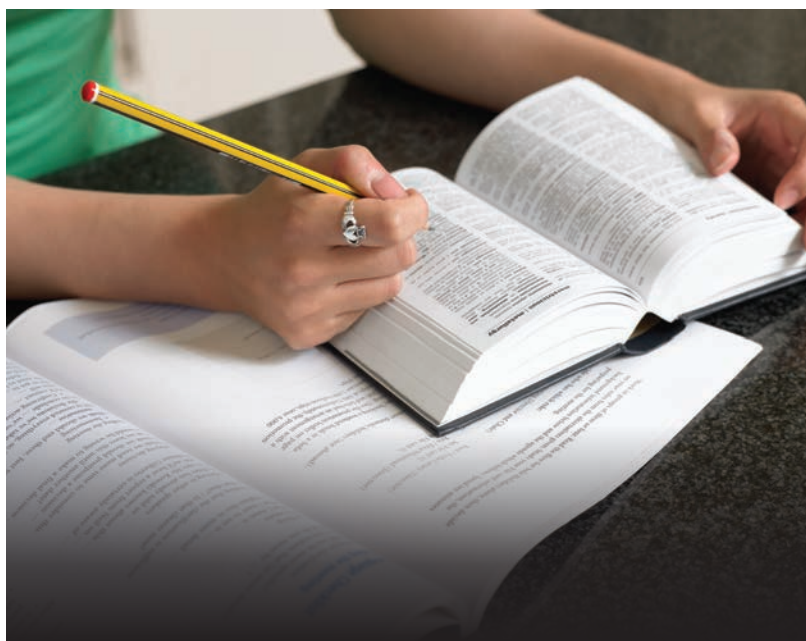
Younger Christians today have been told that early Christians practiced socialism. This is false; the charity practiced by first-century believers was *voluntary*. It was based on the love of God, whereas socialist/Marxist regimes are inherently godless and generally suppress religious freedom.

Furthermore, regarding the groups of people who won’t work (which in socialist societies is well-documented), God’s Word warns that if a man won’t work, he shouldn’t be given free food (2 Thess. 3:10). For those who try and argue that Christianity is somehow compatible with socialism, hard economic facts, history, and the Bible say differently.
