Following God from Colorado to Texas

When Clint and Laura Zeller married, they were not living for the Lord. Though Laura grew up in church, Clint's view was that only "good people go to church." So, when the two discovered that Laura was pregnant with their daughter, they determined to make some changes. Clint decided that since "good people go to church and my daughter is going to be a good person, . . . we're going to go to church."

The Zellers searched online and came across Rocky Mountain Family Church in Pueblo, Colorado. When they visited the church and heard the pastor talk about God as if He was a real person, they

decided to stay. After weeks of attending services and listening to the pastor, Clint made a decision to accept Christ. "It wasn't a big altar call," he says. "It was just a choice in my own heart to finally acknowledge that tug that had been there for a long time."

Clint and Laura began developing relationships and volunteering at their church. They became good friends with the pastor, and Clint soon started imagining himself communicating the Gospel. During a men's Bible study with the pastor, one of the men in the group looked him in the eyes and said, "You feel called to the ministry, don't you?"

"That was the first time I actually acknowledged it out loud," Clint says. "And [it] was just like this weight was lifted off of me." Clint's pastor suggested he check out Andrew Wommack's Bible school in Colorado Springs, but Clint had never heard of Andrew Wommack. As soon as he got home, Clint Googled Andrew and discovered a treasure trove of free teachings!

Clint and Laura attended Charis Bible College's *Campus Days* in March 2011 and enrolled at the school that fall. From day one, Charis changed their lives, but the Zellers knew

in their hearts that Colorado Springs was not their final destination. So, they sold their house and started renting a home. Then, during their third year at Charis, an opportunity arose in Texas: Charis Houston needed a new director. The thought of taking over the school resonated with the Zellers, and during the interview process, they were asked, “When can you leave?”



Recognizing that God had already prepared the way for them, Clint replied, “Tomorrow.” So, in 2014, after graduation, the Zellers packed their belongings and moved to Houston to take over as directors of the Charis campus.

Dealing with the challenges of a leadership change was quite an adjustment, not just for the Zellers but also the students. “I was a little more direct,” Clint says. “I had a lot of army in me. . . . There was no pastor in me.”

But students aren’t the only ones whose lives are impacted through the Charis experience. Leaders are impacted too. “If you were to talk to the students that I had then, [they would say] I’ve changed a lot. . . . We have a church now, and I’m a pastor.”

When asked to elaborate about the impact of following God’s leading, the Zellers share a testimony from their school: Recently in class, one of their students lifted her arm as if she were going to ask a question. Instead of asking something, she began moving her arm around. “I asked her what was going on, and she said [that] for two years she had been experiencing this shoulder pain,” Clint recalls. “She works in



the nursery at her son’s church. She [couldn’t] lift the kids or do her job the right way because her shoulder hurt. And just by sitting in that class and hearing the goodness of God, she was healed.” Clint continues, “We didn’t speak to anything or spit and yell . . . at the devil. We just revealed the heart of the Father, and healing happened.”
