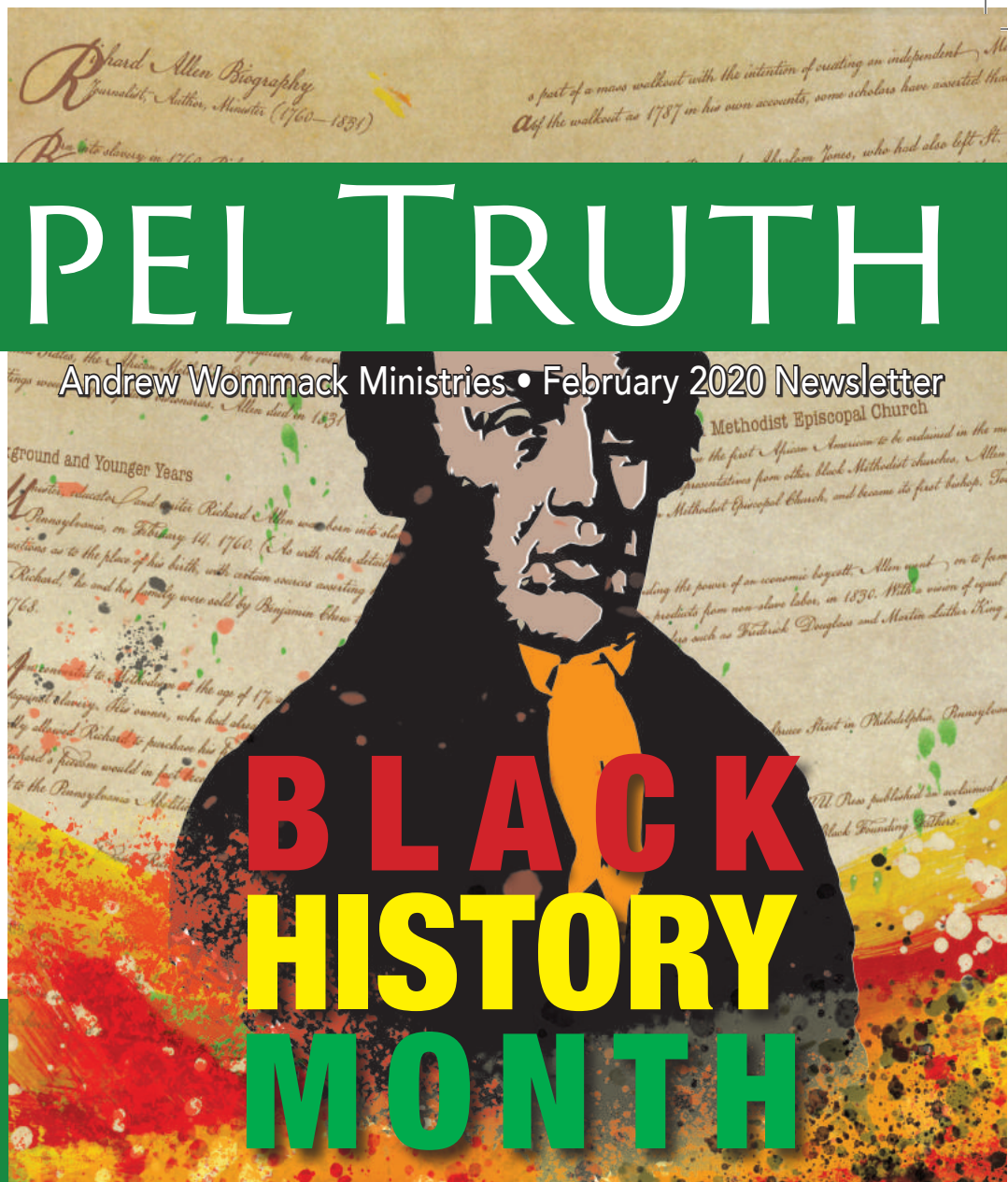

Richard Allen Biography
Journalist, Author, Minister (1760–1831)

Born into slavery in 1760, Richard Allen later became a prominent black church in the United States, the African Methodist Episcopal Church.

Synopsis

Minister, educator, and writer Richard Allen was born into slavery in 1760. He converted to Methodism and bought his freedom. He was a parishioner at the St. George Episcopal congregation, he eventually helped found the African Methodist Episcopal Church. He was also a writer whose writings would inspire future visionaries. Allen died in 1831 in Philadelphia.

Background and Younger Years

Minister, educator, and writer Richard Allen was born in Philadelphia, on February 14, 1760. (No one knows exactly where he was born, but questions as to the place of his birth, with certain names like "Richard," he and his family were sold by his owner in 1768.

Allen converted to Methodism and became a member of the church. He was a parishioner at the St. George Episcopal congregation, he eventually helped found the African Methodist Episcopal Church. He was also a writer whose writings would inspire future visionaries. Allen died in 1831 in Philadelphia.

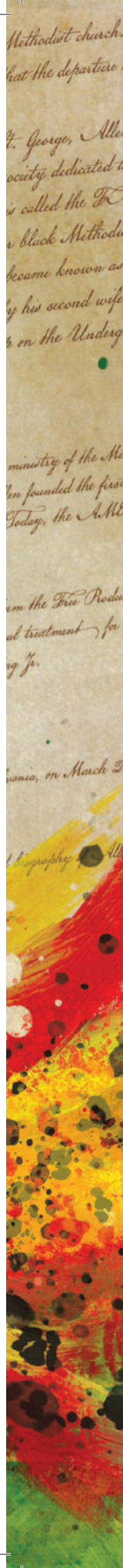
mass walkout with the intention of creating an independent Methodist church. As 1787 in his own accounts, some scholars have asserted that...

Reverend Absalom Jones, who had also left St. George's, a non-denominational religious mutual-aid society, and AMEP founder W.E.B. Du Bois can be seen in Allen's social life." In 1794, Allen and several other black men opened an old blacksmith's shop. Bethel Church became the African Methodist Episcopal Church. Helped by his friends, the basement of the Bethel Church was a stop on the Underground Railroad.

African Methodist Episcopal Church
Allen became the first African American to be ordained in the ministry of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. He was elected from representatives from other black Methodist churches, Allen for the first time became a member of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, and became its first bishop. Today, the church is a major force in the black community. In an economic boycott, Allen went on to form the first black labor union, in 1830. With a vision of equal treatment, Douglass and Martin Luther King Jr. were inspired by his work.

Allen died in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He was buried in the same place where he was born. He was a prominent figure in the black community. He was a minister, educator, and writer. He was a parishioner at the St. George Episcopal congregation, he eventually helped found the African Methodist Episcopal Church. He was also a writer whose writings would inspire future visionaries. Allen died in 1831 in Philadelphia.

BLACK History Month



With this month's newsletter, I want to cover some material about American history that doesn't get much attention. These are things you won't hear in the media or in politics. There are reasons for this, but none of them are good reasons. The absence of talking about these things actually creates another narrative, a divisive one, which is exactly what the enemy wants. He wants to divide and conquer our nation, and he'll use anything he can to trigger hot buttons if it'll drive us apart even more. So, it's important that we as Christians know what God was up to and shed light on the truth so we can stand up for it. We certainly can't wait for the ungodly to do it for us.

Did you know that there are many heroes in our country's heritage and that many of them were black Americans?

You might not have heard that in school, but it's true. In honour of Black History Month, I recently had David Barton and his son Tim on the *Gospel Truth* program to talk about how God used black people throughout American history to shape culture, religion, politics, and every area of society. They brought much more than just another perspective that people can easily write off or ignore. I really believe that God has raised up David and Tim

to be His mouthpiece in this area of America's Christian heritage. He's enabled them to amass an impressive amount of Founding Era documentation that is just overwhelming. David probably has the largest private collection in the world. He's spent years collecting them for public knowledge and education. What a blessing that these things have not been lost to history!

Because God has put David in such a position to gather all these documents, he's been called upon to testify in front of the Supreme Court. He's been described by a major organisation as "America's historian." His organisation, *WallBuilders*, has been fighting to restore truth and righteousness in our country for years. Again, these are not things you're going to hear in many places. God is having to use people like David and Tim to be beacons of truth to help us not be caught up in the fog of confusion and toxicity that is so pervasive today.

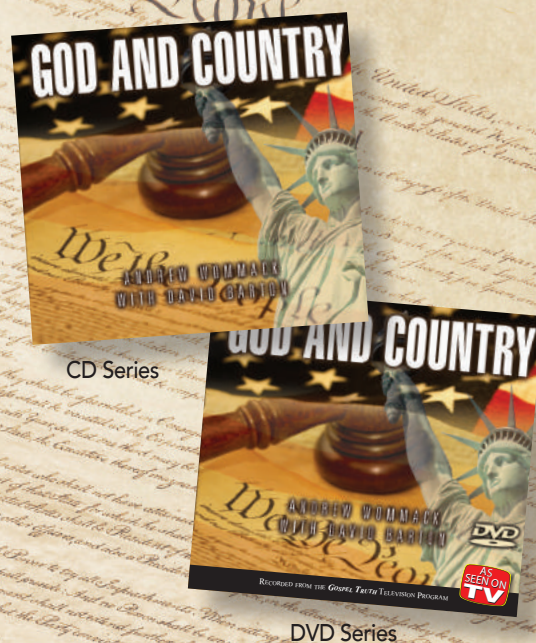
One of the men David talked about is Reverend Richard Allen, who was instrumental in starting the first black denomination, called the African Methodist Episcopal Church. He was a slave on a plantation in Maryland, and then the First Great Awakening revival hit, around 1730. People started getting back to the Bible, back to thinking biblically. It was an amazing time in America's history. A preacher came through the town where Richard was and preached to the slaves. Richard, a teenager at this time, got saved and was on fire for the Gospel! When his master saw the change in Richard's life, he asked him, "Why are you doing all this? It doesn't

make sense." Richard then shared the Gospel with his master and got him saved! Consequently, the master decided he needed to free his slaves, and he did.

Once Richard was free, he ended up in Pennsylvania and continued preaching, and not just in all-black churches. He preached to thousands of white and mixed congregations. He even got trained in medicine and treated hundreds of people when the yellow fever epidemic broke out in Philadelphia in the late 1700s. That's tremendous! Richard made such a huge contribution to our American heritage and was used mightily in one of the greatest revivals we've ever known. He's a great example! There are many others. This is just one of the stories David and Tim shared on the program with me. But today, people don't even know to look for stories like Richard's. They're not well circulated. People are being told to focus on negative points in history, or they're being fed a revisionist history that fits the devil's plot to divide. It's just crazy.

So, I want to tell you about materials that will help you see God's hand at work through America's history. There are so many heroes and there is so much to tell about them, but it's not hard to find. You can go to David Barton's website (wallbuilders.com) and order from the extensive library of materials he has put together. I tell you, I'm not sure there's another resource like his on the face of the earth! You'll be blessed.

I'm also offering an updated version of my album *God and Country*. It includes my interviews with David Barton in 2009 about America's Christian heritage, in 2013 about Thanksgiving, and in 2020 about black Americans throughout American history. CHARIS Honoured before the House of Representatives



God is doing amazing things through Charis Bible College, and the difference we are making is being recognised at state and national levels.

In celebration of Charis Bible College's twenty-fifth anniversary, U.S. Representative Doug Lamborn prepared and read an acknowledgement into the *Congressional Record* on the floor of the House of Representatives. "It's a way that congressmen can recognise and honour exceptional activities, organisations, or individuals in their home districts," says Richard Harris, executive director of the Truth & Liberty Coalition. "During certain times, congressmen can honour achievements of particular citizens by giving remarks on the floor of the House. And that's what Congressman Lamborn did - he chose to recognise Charis Bible College. So, it was a great *honor* to have him to do that."

The record was printed, framed, and then presented to Andrew and Jamie Wommack by Jeff Anderson, Lamborn's senior faith advisor.

Read this excerpt from the *Congressional Record* by Lamborn:

"I am pleased to honour the 25th Anniversary of Charis Bible College. It is nothing short of miraculous to observe the growth that has taken place within the past quarter-century. Charis was founded as Colorado Bible College in 1994 and was originally located in Colorado Springs. Charis has grown from its first graduating class of 33 people in 1996, to include 26 campuses in the United States and 22 international locations."

When asked about why Representative Lamborn chose to honour Charis in this way, Harris said, "It happened because of the strengthening relationship that we have with Congressman Doug Lamborn. He has been a guest on our Truth & Liberty Coalition Live Cast and has welcomed our participation in a meeting to discuss pro-life issues. At our In God We Trust Rally, he prepared a video message that we presented . . . Congressman Lamborn heard about our twenty-fifth anniversary, so he took

the initiative to extend that honour to Charis."

What a blessing!

When Christians stand for righteousness, they will find that they're not alone. Others, even those in positions of power, will take notice and stand with them. Thanks go to Doug Lamborn, who was willing to acknowledge all that God is doing through Charis Bible College! Here is another excerpt from the *Congressional Record* that was read before the House of Representatives, made up of 435 members:

"In my district, the Charis campus provides multiple programs of Bible-based education including a practical government degree. It also hosts faith-based events throughout the year with discussions on Christian art, culture, and politics. Charis Bible College was created by Andrew Wommack, who has been a pioneer in Christian education and ministry. His vision to have men and women steeped in scripture has changed countless lives in my district and around the world."

AWMPACT: *A LEGACY of Discipleship*

For over five decades, Andrew, with the help of his partners, has taught truths from God's Word that have been confirmed with miracles, signs, and wonders. Empowering others to do the same - discipleship - is very dear to Andrew's heart. And that's one of the reasons why Charis Bible College was founded twenty-five years ago.

Barbara Harris from West Palm Beach, Florida, shares about the influence that Charis discipleship had in her own healing from cancer:

"I am an avid student and partner of Andrew Wommack. In June of 2018, I was diagnosed with colon cancer, had three surgeries, and was in the hospital

and rehab for that summer. Because of complications, I had to wear a colostomy bag for eight months. In March of 2019, the colostomy bag was reversed. But in September of 2019, I was re-diagnosed with cancer on a lymph node in my abdomen.

My best friend is a student at Charis Bible College. She helped to show me, through Scripture, that my body was already healed by Jesus when He died on the cross. We talked about this daily until I came to believe that my cancer could be and was healed by the stripes of Jesus. I was told by the Holy Spirit that I would not have to have chemotherapy before I even went to the doctor to talk about treatment. Praise God! Pinpoint radiation was prescribed for treatment.

During the CT scan at the radiation oncologist, I heard my friend's voice in the Spirit say, 'Praise God,' and I thought I might be healed. This morning, the doctor called me to tell me that the lymph node is gone and has disappeared from my body! Praise

God! I was healed by Jesus and the Word! My faith has grown so much, and I believe that cancer will not be a foe again! Hallelujah!

I am currently a Charis Bible College correspondence student . . . I have learned so much from Andrew Wommack and his teachings, and I attribute my revelation of healing to the Word, Charis Bible College, and Andrew Wommack Ministries. Thank you so much!"
