In preparing for our trip to Hungary and the Ukraine, the primary thing I asked God was that He “stretch me” . . . He absolutely did that on this trip in multiple ways, and He also revealed things to me that I hadn’t realised were such a deep part of who I was that I needed to be released from.

One of those things was that I spent most of my life with an understanding that I was to be “seen and not heard” . . .
