Effortless Change

Do you know God has more for you than you're experiencing? If you're like most Christians I've talked to, you likely answered yes.

The reason is because none of us have reached our full potential. We all need to keep pursuing the things of God. John 10:10 says, *"The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it **more abundantly**"* (emphasis added). One translation renders *"more abundantly"* as *"to the fullest."*

Yet the average Christian is living way below what God intended for them, and they don't know how to go from where they are to where they need to be. Instead, they spend a lot of time praying, fasting, and begging God for change. They're waiting on Him to do something.

That's not the way the Scriptures teach us about change. **God has a system of change, and unlike the world's system, it's supposed to be effortless.**

People hear the term "effortless change" and think it's impossible. But *"with God all things are possible"* (Matt. 19:26). Many believe that change has to be traumatic and painful. However, Mark 4 shows us that a seed doesn't travail or groan to change and produce fruit. It's the nature of an apple seed to grow into a tree and then produce fruit. In the same way, God's Word will change our lives for the better, effortlessly. It's the nature of God's Word to bring about change within us.

The verses the Lord used to transform my life back in 1968 were Romans 12:1–2 (emphasis added):

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable



*unto God, which is your reasonable service. And **be not conformed to this world:** but **be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind,** that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

Notice that this passage says, *"And be not conformed to this world."* The word *conform* basically means to be poured into the mold of something. **Life is like a furnace, and your experiences are going to have an impact on you. They will melt you, but you get to pick which mold you fit into.** The same things could happen to two different people, yet one could choose to become better, while the other chooses to become bitter.

During the COVID pandemic, I saw people respond in absolute terror and fear. They based their lives on the fear of a virus that the vast majority of people recover from. It's sad that many Christians are just as sick, fearful, and depressed as those who don't know the Lord. There ought to be a difference.

The fear of death brings people into bondage, but the Word of God can change that fear into faith. Hebrews 2:15 says that Jesus came to *"deliver them*

who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." Unfortunately, our society has become very secular. God has been removed from most people's thinking to such a degree that they are terrified of death because they think this life is all that there is.

God didn't create us to be this way. **We need to change our thinking and begin living life to the fullest like Jesus said in John 10:10.**

We should not be afraid, because we know that "perfect love casteth out fear" (1 John 4:18). We should be walking in health because we know that by Jesus' stripes, we have already been healed (1 Pet. 2:24). We have promises that no plague will come near our dwelling and that God will give His angels charge over us (Ps. 91:10–11).

If you're a Christian, you should be living at a higher level than people who don't know the Lord. You should not be conformed to this world but be "transformed by the renewing of your mind" (Rom. 12:2).

The word *transformed* in Romans 12:2 was translated from the Greek word *metamorphoó*, which is where we get the word *metamorphosis* from, describing the process of a caterpillar spinning a cocoon and then coming out of it a beautiful butterfly.

In order to change from something that is earthbound (and many times ugly and creepy) to something beautiful that soars, you have to renew your mind. **Transformation—or metamorphosis—happens by renewing your mind to God's Word.** This means that the Word of God starts to dominate your thinking.

This may sound too simple. However, you aren't going to change until you change the way you think, because you can't rise above your thoughts. Most people are looking for change from the outside. But change starts in your heart through the renewing of your mind. It doesn't come from the outside in. It comes from the inside out.

Proverbs 23:7 says, "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he." **Your life is going the direction of your dominant thoughts.**

If you're waiting for God to do something to change your circumstances, the ball is in your court. God is waiting on you. He has more for you, and it doesn't have to be traumatic for you to get there. You can change effortlessly.

I share more on this in my *Effortless Change* teaching. It contains some of the most transformative, foundational things that God has ever revealed to me. I can truthfully say that any good thing God has done in my life happened because of these truths. This teaching is available as a book, introductory booklet, or study guide in English or Spanish. 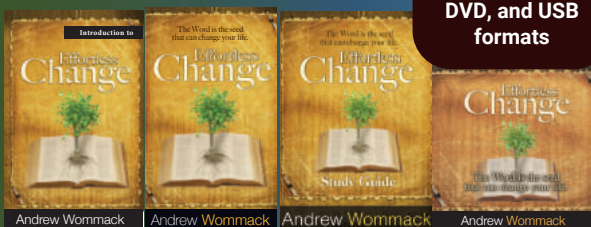

Living a Lifestyle of Intimacy

Carrie is dedicated to spreading God's grace worldwide and raising up powerful ministers with a Great Commission vision.

What does relationship and intimacy with God really look like?

It all starts with spending time in His Word. The Word of God isn't just a book—it's Jesus. That's why it says in John 1:1 and 14a, *"The Word was with God, and the Word was God. . . . And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us."* That's referring to Jesus.

Eternal life and knowing the Lord (John 17:3) stems from His invitation to develop a vibrant, growing, dynamic relationship with Him through the Word of God. Although it may seem daunting to start getting into the Word, God has given us the Holy Spirit to help us and to lead us into all truth (John 16:13).

It's vital to know that God eagerly wants to reveal Himself to you and have a close, loving relationship with you. The enemy will try

to make God seem unapproachable, telling you lies like, *You just can't really know the Lord or what He's going to do.* Lies like that will hinder you from drawing near to Him. After all, why would you want to pursue a relationship with someone who might be volatile or dysfunctional?

Have you ever met someone like that, who's completely unpredictable? You have to walk on eggshells around them because you never know how they're going to respond. One day something's funny to them, and the next time you say it, it makes them angry.

GOD LOVES YOU NOW AND ALWAYS

You don't have to be on a roller coaster, wondering how God is going to treat you today. His Word makes it crystal



clear that He loves you today, right now, and He wants you to know Him.

God's Word isn't a book of "someday" promises. It's a today book! Reading the Scriptures with a "someday" mentality will lead you into wrong, legalistic thinking, like "Someday when I'm good enough," "Someday when God can use me," "Someday when I have more understanding," and so on.

Don't read the Bible with a limited future-tense expectation. Today is the day, and He wants to bless you with His benefits right now (Ps. 68:19). He's already made you righteous in Christ Jesus. Receive that and make a commitment to get in the Word and start developing that intimate relationship with God. Realise there's something special in it just for you.

***I will** meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways. **I will** delight in your statutes; **I will** not forget your word.*

Psalm 119:15–16, *English Standard Version*, emphasis added

I want to challenge you to read the first five to ten verses of Psalm 119 today and then stop and meditate on them. Start living a lifestyle of intimacy with God by making the choice every day to dive deeper into your relationship with the Lord through spending time in His Word.

His passion is to equip believers to engage in the arena of government and fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ.

Seeing what's happening in America and around the world can sometimes feel overwhelming or discouraging. But I firmly believe that God is not done with our nation. He is powerful enough to turn things around and restore America to its divine purpose, and He will work through people to do that. I've learned that God seeks to use us as vessels of His glory to accomplish His will on the earth.

The story of Gideon, found in the book of Judges, has greatly impacted my life and offers a profound example of this. It teaches us that we carry the glory of God—a light capable of overcoming darkness. Despite the Israelites' disobedience, which led to their oppression

by the Midianites, God remained faithful. Even in that dire situation, He found a man willing to listen to His voice—Gideon—and called him to a remarkable purpose.

Gideon's story teaches us three truths about the power of God's glory. First, God's glory lives within us. Second, God's glory is released through our obedience to His calling. Third, when God's glory is released, His enemies are destroyed.

The glory of God is so powerful. Hebrews 1:3 speaks of Jesus Christ as the brightness of God's glory, and Colossians 1:27 tells us that Christ in us is the hope of glory. This same glory that was in Jesus and raised Him from the dead also lives in us!



Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Romans 6:4

Jesus calls us the light of the world and urges us to let our light shine before others (Matt. 5:14 and 16). How? God's glory shines through us when we obey His call. This isn't a one-time event; it's a journey where God leads us step by step. Each act of obedience strengthens our faith and brings us closer to fulfilling His purpose for our lives.

Gideon's journey began with a simple act of obedience—destroying his father's altar to Baal—and despite his fear, he obeyed God, which set the stage for greater victories. God met Gideon where he was and built his faith step by step, leading to a miraculous victory over the Midianites.

God is calling you to fulfill His incredible vision and purpose for your life, and He has already supplied the power to accomplish it. He doesn't call the qualified; He qualifies the called. Despite your doubts or insecurities, He invites you to trust in His power and take that first step of obedience. As you do, you'll witness His glory and victory unfold in your life and across this nation.

John:

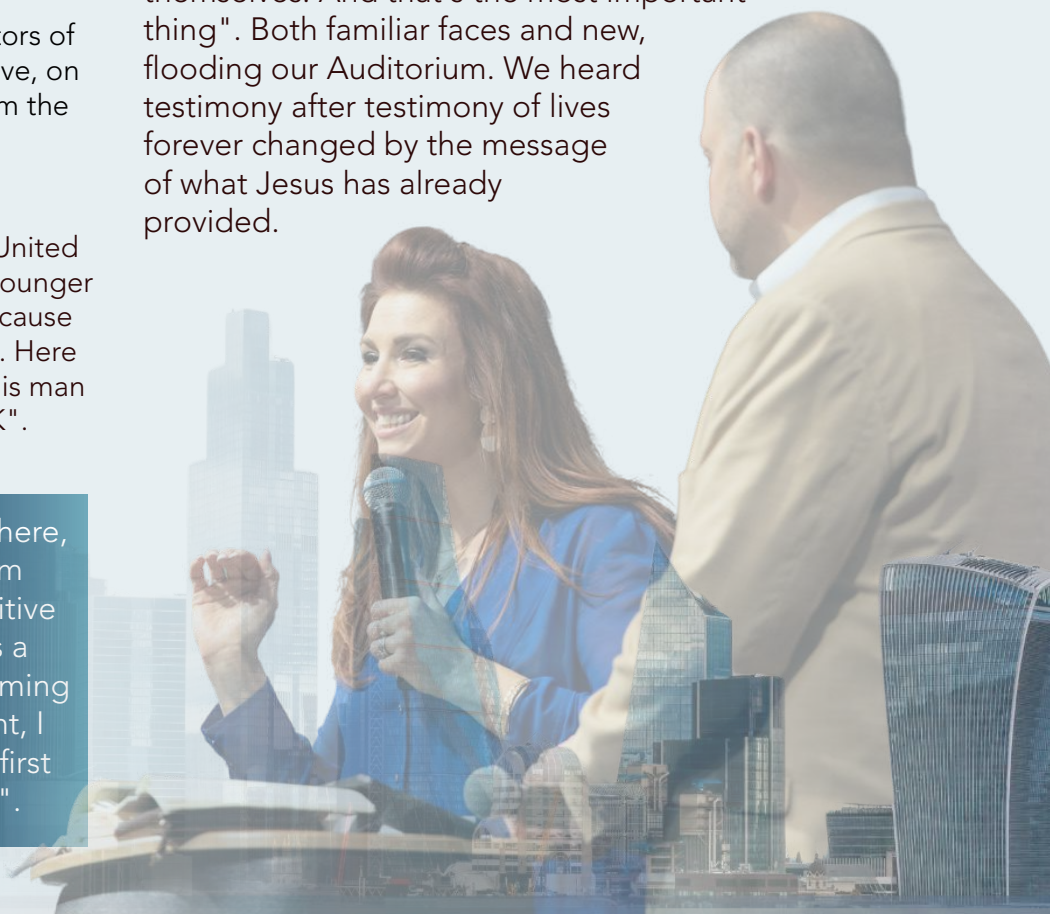

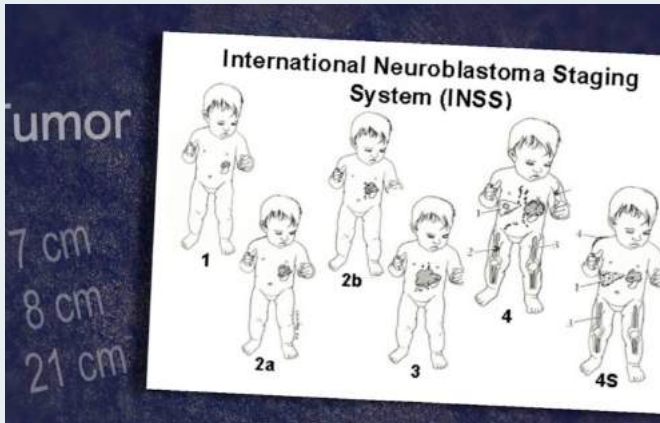


Susan:

God's Healing Grace Is for You!



Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Isaiah 41:10

Gaining a deeper understanding of God's grace can totally transform our lives. For the Mullins family, this became especially evident when their seventeen-month-old son was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer.

When Andrew was born as the fifth child to the Mullins family, his parents, Mike and Aster, were sure he would be the happiest addition yet. Then, when Andrew was seventeen months old, tragedy struck. After experiencing unexplained symptoms followed by an emergency trip to the hospital, he was diagnosed with stage 4 neuroblastoma, a malignant childhood cancer, which had spread to nearly every bone in his body.

Both Mike and Aster were devastated, but they believed in God and clung to the hope that their son would recover. Unfortunately, they had come from a religious background where people prayed for healing but didn't actually expect it.

But that was about to change.

The couple received Andrew Wommack's teaching *God Wants You Well* in the mail from someone who had heard about their son's illness. They listened to it, and it was like a light turned on. Aster immediately knew they could stand on God's Word to believe for their son's healing. So, that's what they did!

They prayed over Andrew's body and bones, declaring that he was healed by the stripes of Jesus. And the

next time he was tested, every one of his bones was completely clean of cancer!

But the battle wasn't over. The Mullins learned there was still an inoperable tumor left on Andrew's spine. Undeterred, they prayed a second time. They laid hands on their son, spoke God's Word

over the tumor, and **knew** that the Word would kill it. The next time Andrew had scans done, he was completely cancer-free!

Today, at the age of fourteen, Andrew lives a happy and healthy life, embodying the joy and dreams his parents always held for him. His story stands as a testament to the power of faith and God's overwhelming grace.

Triumphing Over Challenges: The Power of Confession and Agreement with God

*Can two walk together,
except they be agreed?*

Amos 3:3

How can you walk with God if you don't agree with Him? You can't. But when you learn the power of confession, you can learn to access His power and walk with Him. The word *confession* is found in Romans 10:10, and it's translated from the Greek word *homologeó*, which basically means to say the same thing or to speak agreeable to fact and truth. If you want to overcome like Jesus promised in John 16:33, you're going to have to learn how to walk with God by agreeing with Him and confessing His Word.

*We having the same **spirit of faith**, according **as it is written**, **I believed**, and **therefore have I spoken**; we also believe, and therefore speak.*

2 Corinthians 4:13,
emphasis added

Step three: Speak it out of your mouth.

Declare what God says about you and your situation.

When you agree with the Word, you're agreeing with God. And when you agree with God, you're able to walk with God. That's how you operate in faith. And when you walk and live by faith (Heb. 10:38 and 11:6), that faith is capable of speaking to activate supernatural power.

To overcome difficulties in life through confessing His Word, begin by finding out what the Bible says about your specific situation. For example, if you're going through a physical battle, find a promise like Isaiah 53:5: "*With his stripes we are healed.*" Then confess, "I'm healed by the stripes of Jesus!" If you're experiencing financial lack, find a promise like Philippians 4:19, claim that promise for yourself, and declare it out loud. And when you claim it, believe it.

So confession is believing and agreeing with fact and truth. Jesus said, "*Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth*" (John 17:17). So what should you be confessing? You should be confessing what the Word says. That's how faith is activated. Believe it in your heart, say it with your mouth, and then it comes to pass. And if you or someone you know is facing a health battle and cannot speak, understand that, in that instance, you can intercede. You can pray for them, speak it out, and believe it in your heart and thoughts for them. Faith works!

According to Mark 11:23, you can release faith capable of moving the mountains in your life by speaking what you believe. If you really explore that verse, it reveals three steps of biblical confession.

Three Steps of Biblical Confession

Step one: See it in the Word.

The only thing you can agree with God about is His Word.

Step two: Believe it in your heart.

Know without a shadow of doubt that it's the truth.
