HAPPY 250TH BIRTHDAY, AMERICA!

Praise God for the United States of America!
This is the greatest nation on earth.

God has blessed and used many nations throughout history, but this nation is unique in the sense that it was founded by those who established government for the primary purpose of granting them the freedom to worship God as they saw fit. That godly foundation has brought the blessings of God upon us as no other nation has ever experienced.

Contrary to what some say, this nation was conceived by Christians whose number-one goal was to worship God and have the freedom to live out their faith without the government dictating how they were supposed to do that. It was established as a Christian nation for the glory of God.

There are those who are not celebrating this anniversary because they are focused on everything that's wrong. There is plenty for them to complain about, but in my opinion, that attitude is one of the greatest problems we face. A denial of our godly heritage, a departure from biblical morality, and the promotion of lawlessness are among the greatest threats this nation has ever faced.

As Abraham Lincoln said in 1838,

All the armies of Europe, Asia and Africa combined, with all the treasure of the earth (our own excepted) in their military chest; with a Buonaparte for a commander, could not by force, take a drink from the Ohio, or make a track on the Blue Ridge, in a trial of a thousand years.

At what point then is the approach of danger to be expected? I answer, if it ever reach us, it must spring up amongst us. It cannot come from abroad. If destruction be our lot, we must ourselves be its author and finisher. As a nation of freemen, we must live through all time, or die by suicide.

How prophetic—and how true!

There is no argument that this nation has departed from its godly heritage, but many have been believing and standing firm on scriptures like 2 Chronicles 7:14, which says,

If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

I believe that promise is true, and I believe the Lord has heard our prayers and is in the process of healing our land. The Lord gave me a prophetic word on March 5, 2021, that the Third Great Awakening in this nation had already begun. The signs of that are everywhere for those who have eyes to see it.

Church attendance has begun to increase after decades of decline, and the largest increase is among young men. Bible sales are up about 96% in America since 2019, and even more in some European nations. A cleric in Iran complained that 50,000 of the country's 75,000 mosques had closed their doors because no one was attending. Some estimate that hundreds of thousands of Iranians have come to the Lord in recent years.

And look at this nation. The second term of President Trump is one of the greatest signs of God answering our prayers and intervening in our nation. He overcame unparalleled partisan attacks and two assassination attempts to win reelection by such a large margin that they couldn't rig the vote.

Just think what things would be like if Kamala Harris were president. We would still have open borders with millions of people, including some of the vilest criminals, pouring into our nation and wreaking havoc. Iran might have developed a nuclear weapon by now and even used it. God only knows what the consequences of that would have been.

The transgender lunacy is being confronted, and "Pride Month" is being replaced by "Nuclear Family Month" in some states. Corruption is beginning to be exposed, and those who allowed it will hopefully be brought to justice. The economy has improved, and even though there is temporary pain at the gas pump because of the war in Iran, the prices are still not as high as they were under the Biden administration. That's a small price to pay for avoiding nuclear war.

I could go on and on about the positive things that have taken place right here in America. Sure, there is opposition. The ungodly who have been emboldened by the woke policies of previous years are not going to let go of their gains without a fight. We are in the midst of a cultural war, but I firmly believe that the same God who has brought this nation through so many impossible situations in the past is in the process of doing it once again.

So, as we celebrate the 250th birthday of America, let's focus on all of the blessings God has bestowed upon us and praise the Lord that things are as good

as they are. They could be much, much worse. Just as Jehoshaphat put the praisers at the front of the army (2 Chr. 20), let's offer our highest praises for the wonderful things the Lord has done and for the great things that are yet to be done in this nation and throughout the world. God inhabits the praises of His people (Ps. 22:3).

Let your praise and thanksgiving for His merciful kindness to this nation be a place that the Lord can inhabit. God has certainly blessed America. Amen!

LESSONS FROM DAVID

You Don't Have to Live It to Learn It

Did you know some of the most important lessons you will ever learn already happened to somebody else? God didn't give us the Bible just to inform us—He gave it to transform us. One of the things I love about the Word of God is that it just tells you like it is. It gives you the good, the bad, and the ugly so you can learn from it.

*Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted. Neither be ye idolaters, as were some of them; . . . Now all **these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.***

1 Corinthians 10:6–7 and 11,
emphasis added

These things were written for our learning. They are examples. I can't overstate how important it is for you to learn from other people's lives at their expense, not yours.

I got born again when I was eight years old, and I didn't go through a period of rebellion or spend years running from God. Because of that, some people assume I didn't really learn much. But you don't have to destroy your life to understand destruction. You can look at David's life and learn what sin does without ever committing it yourself. You can see the pain of failure without walking through it personally. That is wisdom—learning through Scripture instead of experience.

Most people think of David as the man after God's own heart—and he was (Acts 13:22). But the Bible never just shows you the highlight reel. It shows everything—his worship *and* his weakness, his courage *and* his compromise, his victories *and* his failures. The Bible doesn't sugarcoat it. It records every rotten detail so we can learn from it.

I've learned some lessons from David that have literally transformed my life. I didn't need to commit adultery to understand the damage it does. I didn't need to cover up sin to learn the heavy consequences it brings. I learned it from David. And I also learned from his victories—his courage against

Goliath, his heart for worship, and his dependence on God when everything else was shaking.

The Trap of People-Pleasing

Before you can really understand David, you have to understand Saul. Saul was Israel's first king, handpicked by God. On the outside, he had everything going for him—tall, impressive, exactly what people expected a king to look like. **But on the inside, he was controlled by something very dangerous: the opinions of people.**

When he was chosen, he hid because he was overwhelmed by what everyone might think about him—and that was the root of his problem. Because when you live for approval, you will eventually stop obeying God in order to protect your image.

Proverbs 29:25 says, "*The fear of man bringeth a snare.*" It doesn't just influence you—it traps you.

Even when Saul was anointed, that insecurity didn't disappear. It just waited for pressure. And that pressure came at Gilgal (1 Samuel 13). The Philistines outnumbered Saul's army big-time. The men were scattering, fear was rising, and Samuel didn't arrive when Saul expected him. So Saul was faced with a decision: wait on God or take control himself. He chose to act.

He offered the sacrifice himself, something he was never supposed to do, and he knew it. He forced it. When Samuel showed up, Saul tried to blame the circumstances and the pressure, but there's never a good excuse for disobeying God. Samuel said to him, "*Thou hast done foolishly: . . . The LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart*" (1 Sam. 13:13–14). That moment didn't just expose Saul's mistake—it redirected the future of Israel. That is huge.

Saul's life also shows something important about the anointing of God. When the Spirit of the Lord came upon him in 1 Samuel 11:6–7, he became bold and acted differently than his natural personality. That is what the anointing does—it empowers you beyond your ability. I've seen that in my own life, moments where God spoke and suddenly there was a boldness I didn't have before. But here is the key: the anointing is never a

substitute for obedience. You can be empowered and still miss God if you choose fear over faith.

And this is where it gets very practical. Life will pressure you. Circumstances will argue with you. Fear will try to talk you out of obedience. But obedience to God is not based on convenience, outcome, or risk. It is based on trust. Most people decide obedience based on consequences, but real obedience is settled before the pressure comes.

You need to ask yourself if you're going to learn from David or repeat Saul. The fear of man will trap you, and pressure will expose you. So you just need to obey God and leave the results up to Him. That alone will save you years of frustration if you learn it.

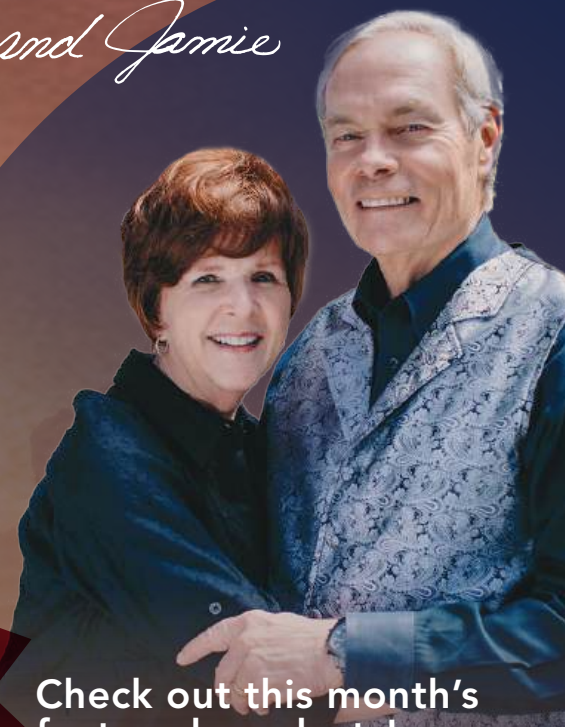
The truth is, if you don't learn these things at David's expense, you're going to learn them at your own. But even if you've already messed up, you can take encouragement from David. He was a man who

messed up just about as much as anybody possibly could, and yet God did not forsake him. God hasn't forsaken you either (Heb. 13:5).
