HEALING TRUTH & TESTIMONIES

DOES GOD WANT YOU HEALED?

One of the biggest reasons people struggle to believe in healing is not because they outright reject it. Most people want to be healed. But deep down, they struggle to believe that it's God's will to heal every person, every time. Why? I believe it's a defense mechanism—a way of coping when they don't see healing manifest immediately.

I can tell you with certainty that anyone who has ever prayed for the sick has not seen every single person healed right away. That's not because it isn't God's will, but because we live in a world flooded with unbelief and wrong thinking. People have been taught doctrines that make them passive about healing, and they settle for sickness instead of standing on God's promises.

A FATHER'S STRUGGLE WITH GOD'S WILL

I remember ministering at a church years ago and saying that it was always God's will to heal. A man in the congregation got so mad that he stormed out. His twelve-year-old daughter was quadriplegic, unable to talk, and unable to think clearly—completely dependent on her parents for everything. And in his pain, this father had come to believe that God had made her that way for a reason. He had convinced himself that in God's wisdom, He had chosen this path for his daughter.

After the service, the man stayed to talk. As I knelt in front of his daughter's wheelchair, he confronted me. "Are you saying it's God's will for her to be well?" he demanded. "God made her this way." I shared scripture with him, but we were getting nowhere. He was convinced that if she had been born this way, then God must have ordained it.

Finally, I asked him a question that changed everything: "What kind of dad are you to want your daughter to be like this? Why would you want her to be in a wheelchair—unable to talk, unable to think, and need her diapers changed at twelve years old?"

His face turned red with anger. If his daughter hadn't been between us, I think he might have hit me. "How dare you say that?" he shouted. "I love my daughter! I would do anything for her. If I could, I would trade places with her so she could be like me!" I let his words hang in the air for a moment. Then I said, "And you think God loves her *less* than you do?"

He had just admitted he would do anything to see his daughter well, yet he believed that God—who is love—wanted her to stay in that condition. How could that be? Jesus said in Luke 11:11 and 13,

If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? . . . If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give . . .

God is infinitely more loving than we are! If we, in our human frailty, desire healing for our loved ones, how much more does our heavenly Father want us whole?

THE TRUTH ABOUT HEALING

Many have been taught that healing is a mystery—that sometimes God says yes, and sometimes He says no. But that's not what Scripture says.

For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

2 Corinthians 1:20

God has already said yes to healing. First Peter 2:24 says, "*By whose stripes ye were healed.*" It's already been done. So, why do so many struggle to receive?

For some, it's a way to avoid the responsibility of faith. They can live with sickness, blame God for it, and never have to step out and believe. But the truth is, walking in divine health takes effort. You don't just drift into healing. It's like climbing a mountain—it takes faith, persistence, and a refusal to settle for anything less than God's best.

But too often, people wait until they are in a crisis to start believing. When they get a diagnosis, suddenly they begin seeking God, reading the Bible, praying, and attending church. But faith isn't meant to be a last resort—it's meant to be a lifestyle.

JESUS REVEALED THE FATHER'S WILL

The foundation of faith for healing goes back to Jesus. Hebrews 1:3 says that He is the "express image" of God—meaning He perfectly represented the Father in everything He did. Jesus made it clear in John 5:19 and John 8:28 that He did nothing apart from God. If that's true, then God cannot be the source of sickness, because Jesus never put sickness on anyone.

There's not a single instance in the Gospels where Jesus refused to heal someone. Instead, Scripture records seventeen times where He healed every sick person present and forty-seven instances where He healed one or two at a time. If Jesus was revealing God's will, then healing must be God's will. Acts 10:38 confirms this, saying Jesus "went about doing good, and healing all that were

oppressed of the devil." Who was doing the oppressing? The devil. Who was doing the healing? Jesus. There is zero confusion here.

GOD'S WILL TO HEAL—ALWAYS

Jesus is the answer to every question about healing. He is the perfect image of God. If you believe sickness is from God, then you must also believe Jesus misrepresented Him. But Jesus only did what the Father did. He never made anyone sick; He only healed. That is the heart of God. It is always God's will for you to be well. Always. The question is, will you believe it?

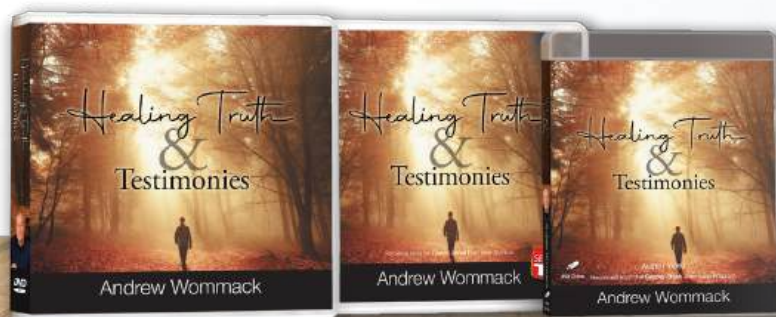

GOD ISN'T THE AUTHOR OF SICKNESS—HE'S THE ANSWER TO IT

Neresa Jones never imagined the greatest crisis of her life would strike during what should have been one of its happiest moments—pregnancy. A former professional soccer player in excellent health, she was eight months along when everything changed.

"It started with a headache," she recalled. "The next day, I couldn't see clearly. My hearing went out in one ear. I was in massive pain."

Doctors admitted her immediately, but they had no answers. Her blood pressure surged to dangerously high levels. Her nervous system became inflamed, causing such intense pain that she couldn't lie down to sleep. For nearly six months, she had to sleep upright in a beanbag chair.

"Anything that touched me felt like a level-20 pain," she said.

Even in the middle of her suffering, Neresa leaned on her faith—but with a belief that only added to the confusion. "I loved God. I was in the Word. But I thought this sickness was something He was using to teach me." She echoed the well-meaning but misguided advice many Christians hear in crisis: *Maybe God is humbling you. At least it's you and not your child.*

Even though her son was born healthy, her own condition worsened. With no answers, the hospital sent her home after two months. Bedridden with a newborn and a two-year-old she couldn't touch due to the pain, her husband did everything he could to keep the family afloat.

Doctors prescribed thirteen medications a day, including antidepressants, and discussed admitting her to the psych ward. "They diagnosed me with multiple sclerosis, lupus—but then they found out that it was my nervous system being squeezed." In a desperate attempt to relieve the pressure, surgeons cut open part of her skull. But things only got worse. "I couldn't turn my head for months. Soon, I slid into depression and had suicidal thoughts."

But everything shifted when she discovered Andrew Wommack's teachings. "I began to binge-watch all of Andrew's free material and got a hold of the truth." Over time, Neresa came to realise that God wasn't the author of her pain—He was the answer to it. As she renewed her mind with the Word, the symptoms began to lift, and she was able to come off all the medications. "If I'd known the truth back then, the surgery on my skull never would've happened."

As her health was restored, Neresa and her family moved to Colorado to attend Charis Bible College. There, her relationship with God deepened, her hair grew back, her marriage was healed, and their finances prospered. Today, Neresa is strong and thriving—running up to eleven miles at high altitude!

Now, as the Healing Discipleship Program coordinator, she shares the same truths that changed her life. From diagnosis to freedom in two years, her story is living proof that the Word works in every area.

THE DAY HEALING TOOK ROOT: MIKE'S MIRACULOUS STORY

Mike Hoesch's healing testimony is an extraordinary story of God's power at work. For eight long years, Mike battled a growing tumour on his chest—a malignant neoplasm that defied prayer, medical advice, and everything he thought he knew about faith. It wasn't until he truly understood what Jesus had already done for him that he saw healing take root—not just in his body, but in his heart and mind.

It all began with a minor lesion on his chest that oozed and bled. At the time, Mike was a Spirit-filled believer. "I didn't think anything of it," he recalled. "I basically just ignored it."

Like many of us, Mike believed in healing. He commanded. He rebuked. He prayed. But nothing changed. Even after Mike's pastor prayed for him, the tumour kept growing. When Mike finally went to see a doctor, the diagnosis was serious: a malignant tumour. Fear hit him hard, and surgery was immediately scheduled for two days later. But by the next morning, the fear from that initial appointment had gripped Mike so strongly that he knew he couldn't move forward. So he cancelled the surgery.

A doctor called—angry and alarmed—warning, "You're dealing with a deadly thing!" But Mike had already made up his mind. "I recognised I was in fear, and you should never make a decision when you're in fear." That pause—taking time to deal with the fear before making a decision—was a turning point. He turned to God and His Word. "It took months," he said, "but I stayed in the Word until the fear left."

Still, the tumour worsened. His body weakened. But what changed was his mindset. "In 2008, I received the truth that my healing was already accomplished," he shared. "Even though I still had the symptoms, the tumour was no longer part of me."

That shift came through understanding the Word—seeing that healing wasn't something he had to earn, but something already given. Ephesians 4:27 says, "Neither give place to the devil." Mike realised that through performance-based thinking—believing God responded to him based on how well he was doing—he had unknowingly opened a door to the enemy.

One of the biggest hindrances to healing is thinking that we have to do something to be worthy of it. That kind of mindset puts the burden of healing on us, not on God. And that's not grace—that's striving. Mike's story challenges us to examine where our faith truly lies. Are we trusting in our own effort—or in what Jesus has already done?

CANCER DEFEATED: A TESTIMONY OF UNDETERRED FAITH

What do you do when the devil attacks with the same sickness a second—or even third—time? When Susan received a devastating report of metastasized breast cancer in her neck, she was faced with a choice: agree with the diagnosis or stand firm on God's Word.

Having listened to Andrew's teachings for years, Susan had filled her heart with truth. When this battle came, she chose to believe what God said about her healing. As Psalm 107:20 declares:

He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Determined to immerse herself in faith, Susan attended our **Healing Is Here** conference, where she was surrounded by like-minded believers. A couple on the prayer team prayed with her, and Susan began to step out in faith. She shared:

I kept wanting to feel my neck, and I finally just told myself, Like Andrew says—we live by faith and not by sight. And feeling my neck is carnal, so I'm going to stop feeling my neck.

This was a pivotal step for Susan. Each time she checked for the lump and still felt it, her emotions would sink. Realising it was dragging her down, she chose instead to exalt God's Word above her circumstances.

After the conference, Susan returned to the Mayo Clinic for an updated scan. She told the doctor, "My hope is that nothing is there, because I know Jesus paid for this over two thousand years ago." When the results came back, the doctor called with the news: "There's nothing there. There is no evidence of any of it."

Susan's story is a powerful reminder that faith isn't about feelings—it's a decision to trust God no matter what. Today, more than three years later, Susan remains completely cancer-free! She's enjoying life with her family and boldly sharing her testimony with others.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony.

REST IS YOUR WEAPON: LIVING IN THE FINISHED WORK OF CHRIST

Are you tired of striving for healing, wondering when your breakthrough will come? I want to share with you a powerful revelation that changed my life: rest is not a sign of weakness—it's a weapon of victory.

So many believers today are exhausted. They're speaking to their symptoms, confessing Scripture, and doing everything they know to do, but they're still struggling. Does that sound like you? If so, I've got good news: God never called you to work for what He's already given you. Healing isn't something you have to chase down or earn—it's already yours in Christ!

The enemy wants you stuck in a cycle of trying to get what you already have. Why? Because if he can keep you striving, he can keep you distracted from the truth: *"It is finished"* (John 19:30). Jesus declared those words on the cross, and He meant it. When He completed the work of redemption, He didn't leave anything undone—not your salvation, not your healing, not your righteousness.

Many people believe God *can* heal them, but they struggle to believe that He *will*. But the truth is, if you are in Christ, healing is already alive in you! Just like you don't wake up every morning wondering if you're forgiven, you don't have to wonder if you're healed. Healing is part of your new identity as a believer. That's why Paul told us in Ephesians 6:10–11,

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

God has given us spiritual armour—not to look at but to put on and keep on! And one of the most powerful weapons we have is resting in what Jesus has already done. When we truly grasp the reality of our righteousness in Him, every attack of the enemy loses its grip.

It's time to stop waiting for a manifestation and start standing in the truth. You don't need to convince God to heal you; He's already done it! Rest in that truth and watch healing flow effortlessly in your life.

ABORTION, CANCER, AND THE GOD WHO HEALS IT ALL

Connie Weiskopf's story is not easy to hear—but it reveals the incredible compassion and healing power of God. Her life, once marked by trauma, shame, and deep regret, has become a testimony of redemption, healing, and purpose.

Today, Connie leads the Boulder Pregnancy Resource Center, located just down the street from one of the largest abortion providers in the nation. Boulder, Colorado, has become a hub for abortion access, especially with some of the laws passed in Colorado following the overturning of *Roe v. Wade*. While that landmark decision saved thousands of babies' lives, it also led to a rise in chemical abortions—pills marketed as a "quick fix" but carrying devastating consequences for women who often don't realise how far along they are in their pregnancies.

"We're seeing women come into our center traumatised," Connie explains. "We do after-abortion care too and are taking them through healing because their hearts need to be healed as well as their physical bodies."

Connie understands this kind of emotional pain intimately. Before giving her life to the Lord, she had three abortions—each one adding another layer of grief and shame to her heart. *Why would God heal me after doing something so horrific?* she wondered, believing she didn't deserve healing. "I didn't know about God's healing yet, and that it was for me."

It wasn't until she heard the truth of the Gospel that she began to see her value through God's eyes. "Jesus paid the price for all of us to have that healing," she says. "That was part of His atonement."

But Connie's story doesn't stop there. Years later, she was diagnosed with breast cancer. Still carrying the weight of old shame, she struggled to believe she could be healed. Though she had given her life to Jesus nearly a decade earlier, she had never been taught that physical healing was hers—not something to earn, but a gift already given.

She credits Andrew Wommack's teaching *You've Already Got It!* and testimonies like Niki Ochenski's, shared through Andrew's ministry, with helping her grow in faith. "God's not a respecter of persons," she says. Seeing what God had done for others gave her hope that He could do the same for her—and He did. Connie was completely healed—not only of cancer, but of the emotional scars from her past. Reflecting on women who promote abortion, she says, "I think their hearts just need healing. A lot of them have probably had abortions themselves."

Hosea 4:6 says, "*My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.*" For years, Connie lived in that lack. Now she walks in truth—and helps other women do the same. As you reflect on Connie's story, ask yourself, *What lies are keeping me from receiving God's healing?* The price has already been paid. Will you receive it?

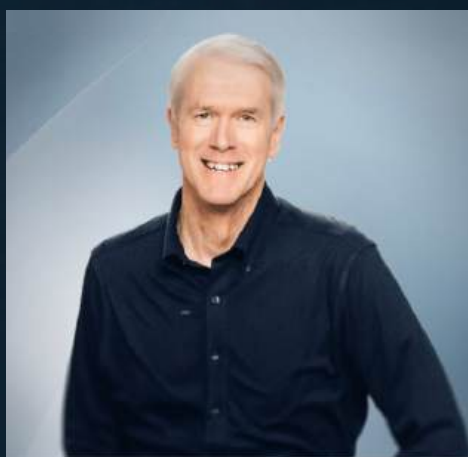
FUN FACTS

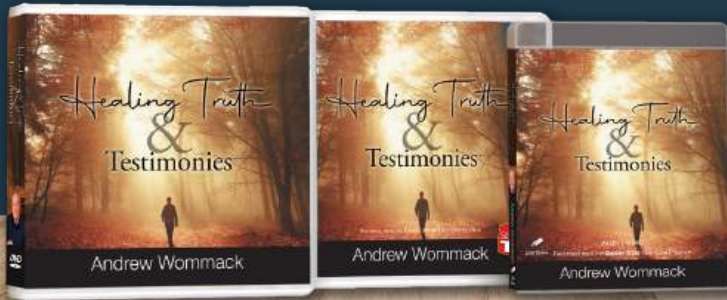
