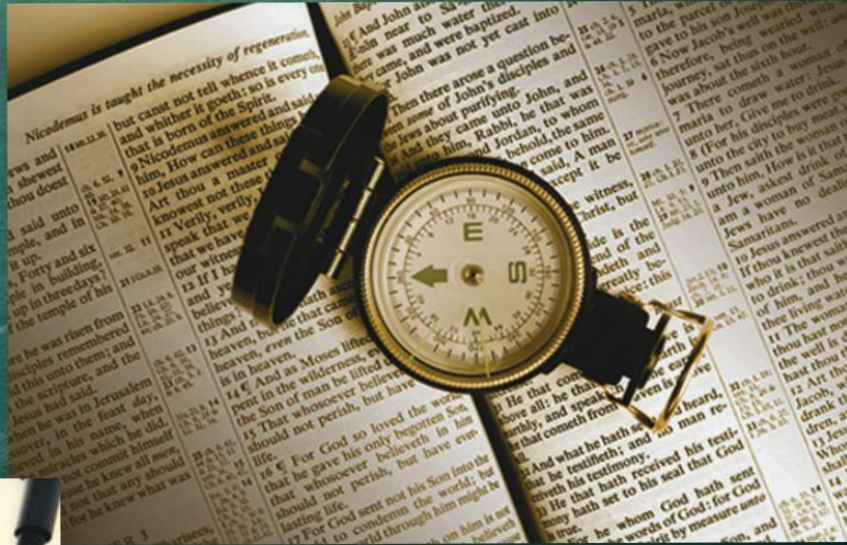

HOW TO FIND, FOLLOW, FULFILL GOD'S WILL

What if the greatest difference you could ever make begins with simply discovering what God created you to do? You were created with a purpose. And when that purpose is ignored, something essential is missing—not just for you, but for the people God intended to bless through you.

How God Changes Lives—and Nations

Years ago, I had the privilege of visiting Oral Roberts just a few months before he passed away. He was physically weak, but the wisdom he carried was as sharp as ever. During that visit, one of the ministers who was present asked him a question that caught everyone's attention: "How do you change a nation?" My ears perked up because I really wanted to hear his answer.

Oral didn't hesitate. He said, "You can't do anything to change a nation. All you can do is what God calls *you* to do. And when other people do what God has called *them* to do, He is able to knit those things together—like a sweater or garment. Only God can change a nation."

That really stuck with me. God flows *through* people. His power works **in us**, not independently of us.

Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.

Ephesians 3:20, emphasis added

Your Calling Is Bigger Than You Think

I see this principle play out constantly. Recently, I sat down with a lot of my executives—some who've been with the ministry for decades. They're people God brought into my life in very different ways and at very different seasons. Looking back, none of us could have planned this. But God led each of us individually and then brought us together to do something none of us could have done alone. That's how God works.

Your calling isn't just about your happiness, though it absolutely affects that. God told Abraham, "*I will bless thee . . . ; and thou shalt be a blessing*" (Gen. 12:2). God blesses you so that He can bless others through you. If you don't discover what God's call on your life is, someone who needs what you

have will go without the blessing that God intended to give them.

Every Role Matters—Visible or Not

Many people assume that only those with public platforms have a calling. That simply isn't true.

Every person matters. Every role matters. I've told my staff for years—whether someone is teaching, managing, cleaning, or working behind the scenes—each one is essential. Faithfulness in small things matters to God. Jesus said, "*He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much*" (Luke 16:10).

I once worked with a woman who duplicated cassette tapes back when we distributed teaching that way. She realised something powerful: she was just as much a part of getting the Word out as the person speaking. And once she owned that, it transformed how she worked. If you aren't doing your part, something is missing.

God's Will Is Not Automatic

One of the biggest misunderstandings about God's will is the idea that it happens automatically—that God just overrides your choices and makes things turn out the way He wants. That's not true. God does not control your life like you're a robot. He gives you freedom. "*I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life*" (Deut. 30:19).

You know, this ought to be a no-brainer. God gives direction and even gives you the answer—but **it's your choice**. If God controlled everything, He would be responsible for divorce, addiction, abuse, and destruction. That's not the case. Scripture makes it clear: God has a plan, but you must choose to pursue it.

You Must Seek God—with Your Whole Heart

I've heard people say, "I asked God what His will was, but He didn't answer."

Jeremiah tells us otherwise: "*Ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart*" (Jer. 29:13).

Casual seeking won't get you there. As long as you can live without knowing God's will, you will. But when you reach the place where you say, "I'm not going any further until God shows me," He will respond. I guarantee it. God is not hiding His will. He is waiting for wholehearted pursuit.

Following God Often Means Swimming Upstream

When God first showed me what He wanted me to do, it went against everything I had planned. It didn't make sense naturally. I lost approval. I lost security. I faced criticism from nearly everyone around me. But I had joy. I had peace. And I knew I was doing what God told me to do.

Jesus said His yoke is easy and His burden is light, but that doesn't mean it's popular or comfortable. Scripture says we must "*labour therefore to enter into that rest*" (Heb. 4:11). There is effort involved in resisting the flow of the world and choosing God's path. An old dead fish can float downstream. Living fish swim upstream.

What Brings Peace

There is a peace that only comes from being in the center of God's will. Isaiah says, "*Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee*" (Is. 26:3). Sometimes the reason you lack peace isn't confusion—it's because you aren't doing what God told you to do.

I've been in moments where I knew without a doubt I was exactly where God wanted me, and the peace was overwhelming. That kind of peace doesn't come from circumstances. It comes from obedience.

You were created for a specific purpose. If you try to use your life for something God didn't design it for, it won't fit. It's just like using the wrong tool for the job—it creates damage instead of progress. If you seek God with all your heart, you will find His will. If you don't, you won't. It really is that simple.

HOW TO RELEASE TRANSFORMATION POWER

Do you want to experience real transformation in your life? The good news is that true transformation isn't something you have to strive for or force. It comes by grace through faith. And faith begins when you learn to see, trust, and speak what God has already promised.

Where Transformation Begins

Everything starts with God's promises. The verse below tells us that these Old Testament believers didn't just know about God's promises—they saw them, embraced them, and confessed them, even before they came to pass.

These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

Hebrews 11:13, *New King James Version*

These believers looked ahead to promises they hadn't yet received. We're in an even greater position today. We get to look back at what God has already fulfilled through Jesus Christ.

That's why time in the Word is so important. When you read Scripture, you're not just gaining information—you're being reminded of what already belongs to you in Christ. As those promises sink into your heart, faith begins to grow. And that's where transformation starts taking root.

How Faith Gets Released in Your Life

Faith doesn't stay hidden inside—it comes out. One of the primary ways it's released is through your words:

And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak.

2 Corinthians 4:13, *NKJV*

Jesus demonstrated this through His ministry. He spoke to storms, trees, sickness, evil spirits—and things changed. He wasn't reacting to circumstances; He was speaking from faith. And He invites us to live the same way.

James compared words to a ship's rudder. Although a ship is large and the winds are strong, a small rudder determines where it goes:

Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires.

James 3:4, *NKJV*

In the same way, when you choose to speak God's promises instead of fear, frustration, or feelings, you begin steering your life toward His truth.

Transformation happens when God's promises move from the page to your heart—and then out of your mouth. As you search the Word and boldly speak what God says about your health, finances, relationships, and future, you position yourself to see His promises come to pass. ■

GOD MADE YOU FOR SOMETHING BIGGER THAN YOURSELF

What do you do when God places an opportunity in front of you that feels beyond your abilities? You really have two choices: shrink back from the challenge or lean into His strength and take a step of faith.

When Rebecca was invited to help translate materials for our World Outreach Department, she chose to press in and depend on God's ability rather than her own. She wasn't a professional translator and felt unqualified, yet she rose to the challenge and stepped forward anyway. Not only did the work bring her joy and purpose, but it also became a powerful opportunity for spiritual growth.

"Translating is something I really enjoy, and it has enabled me to go deeper into Andrew's teachings, because you're not just listening—you're working through what it all means and how to convey it," Rebecca shares. "France really needs this message. Their approach to Christianity is to perform, to earn God's love and grace. And Andrew's message enables people to come out of that religion."

Even though she didn't feel qualified, Rebecca's courageous step of faith is now helping impact France with the Word of God. Her story echoes the time when Peter asked Jesus to call him out onto the water:

And he [Jesus] said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

Matthew 14:29, brackets added

At Jesus' word, Peter stepped out of the boat and walked on the very waves that had moments before

seemed ready to overwhelm him. By keeping his eyes on Jesus and taking a step of faith, he experienced one of the greatest miracles recorded in Scripture.

Opportunities from the Lord may feel beyond your comfort zone, but He doesn't ask you to handle them alone. He calls you to depend on Him as you follow where He leads. You don't need to see the entire path—just the next step. As you walk in faith and obedience, you can expect to see God do more than you could imagine.

On December 12th, 2025, we acquired the stewardship of GOD TV. This was a huge move for the Ministry, and we are excited about what this new partnership will mean for the future of the Ministry and this wonderful, global TV network.

GOD TV has been ministering around the globe for 30 years. Its signal reaches every continent on Earth, and it is the third-largest Christian network globally, airing in 125 countries and reaching approximately 500 million homes worldwide.

About GOD TV

The Bible tells us not to "despise the day of small beginnings" (Zech 4.10). Never has this been truer than at the start of GOD TV. With no denominational backing and very little funding, "The GOD Channel" first began broadcasting across the UK in October 1995, airing for three early morning hours on the UK's largest satellite network, SKY TV. Quickly expanding to 24/7, GOD TV began broadcasting across the UK & Europe through anointed Christian Media in a way never seen outside the US. In 2001, following the Lord's leading, GOD TV moved its broadcast facilities to Israel and, in doing so, opened up broadcast opportunities across India and Africa.

What began as a dream in the hearts of its founders, Rory & Wendy Alec, has expanded over the last 30 years to cover the globe with a message of hope, using media to bring the Gospel to the nations.

Our GOD TV team shares, "But the story of its biggest impact and largest reach is yet to be written. And that chapter begins right now as GOD TV comes under the stewardship of Andrew Wommack Ministries. Truly, the best is yet to come!"

In speaking of their goal and vision, the team shares, **"Our mandate is the same as it's always been, to reach the whole world with the Good News of Jesus through media (in all its forms), bringing hope, reconciliation, and the promise of eternal life."** They also desire to be known as a trusted home of Christian content, hope that this Gospel will be broadcast "free forever," and that everyone who connects with GOD TV on air, online, or on social media can experience true "Jesus moments" that will elevate and enliven their walk with the Lord.

First Corinthians 4:2 says, 'Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.' That's what we're called to do—be faithful stewards of what God has already built."

With the resources now available to us through both ministries, "we can reach more lives in more ways than previously imaginable," Andrew shares. **"The Lord has been so faithful, and I know He has good things ahead. Together, we will continue reaching people, encouraging believers, and advancing the kingdom of God around the world."**
