STEPPING OUT IN FAITH TO LEAD CHARIS BIBLE COLLEGE DUMFRIES THE JOURNEY OF SIREON AND RUTA REID

The journey to becoming a Charis Bible College or Andrew Wommack Ministries Director can be as unique as the Director themselves. But one thing that unites every leader is the choice to serve with excellence, humbly stewarding each assignment from God along the way.

Sireon Reid's journey began while serving as a missionary in Italy, where he started to feel prompted to attend a Bible college. Although he knew he needed to grow in the Word, he was unsure of what God's direction for his life would be after graduating. That made it difficult to commit to a school, as many of them seemed to specialise in specific callings like pastoring or music ministry.

One day, a friend of his mom's received a packet of information about Charis and passed it on to Sireon after he returned home to England. It contained a brochure with an intriguing slogan on the front. Sireon recalls, "It said, 'Discover

Your Destiny. Prepare To Live It.' I thought it was amazing." Remarkably, Sireon recognised Andrew Wommack's face from a single book, *Sharper than a Two-Edged Sword*, that he had read a few years earlier. "I really enjoyed that book," he remembers, "but I had no idea who Andrew was."

After Sireon realised there was a Charis campus near his mother's home, he visited and made the decision to enrol in 2017. He recalls, "Coming to Charis and sitting under the Word began revolutionising my whole world. It transformed my relationship with God and renewed my mind in a massive way. I began to see God change my heart and also work through me."

While attending Charis in England, Sireon met a fellow student, Ruta, who would eventually become his wife. Ruta shares, "We became really good friends. We really clicked, and I thought that our friendship was a beautiful and rare thing."

Sireon and Ruta continued their studies at Charis, staying faithful in small tasks—serving at events, stacking chairs, and working as door

greeters. A desire to spread God's message of unconditional love and grace took root in their hearts, and God began preparing them for something bigger.

After getting married and completing the third-year Directors Training Program at Charis, Sireon and Ruta felt honoured to accept an offer to be the new Directors of Charis Dumfries. They've since welcomed a beautiful baby girl into the world and now reside in Scotland, where they get to help guide students into the same revelation knowledge that transformed their own lives.

Sireon shares, "There was a season when I didn't think I was able to do anything other than stack chairs or help fix things. But after growing through Charis and the training there, I've come to understand that God has put a lot more on the inside of me than I could ever have asked for or imagined." Now Sireon and Ruta are on a mission to help Charis students grow in the Word. Sireon explains, "I want to see them draw on what God has put inside of them so they can go forward and become world changers."
