THE *LIVING COMMENTARY*: HELPING YOU STUDY THE BIBLE

One of the reasons that some people don't get much out of the Bible is because they read it like a history book about what happened thousands of years ago. But you have to read it with an open heart and ask God to teach you through what you read.

It's really important to understand Scripture for yourself, not just repeat what someone else says. That's why I created the ***Living Commentary***—to help believers understand Scripture as it's written, not filtered through preconceived doctrines that come out of cemetery . . . I mean seminary. Over the years, I've written notes on thousands of verses—from Genesis all the way to Revelation.

Here's a practical example. Many people read the story of Joseph in Genesis and think he was an arrogant, spoiled kid, and that's why his brothers hated him. But look at Genesis 37:4:

And when his brethren saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him.

The reason his brothers hated him wasn't Joseph's fault—it was Jacob's favoritism. And when Joseph had dreams and shared how God would one day exalt him, it only made things worse. The worst we can say about Joseph is that he was seventeen—immature, maybe naive—but certainly not malicious. That fits with everything else Scripture shows about him.

The *Living Commentary* not only has my own personal notes and revelations on nearly 28,000 verses, but it also includes Greek and Hebrew word definitions, references, and just all kinds of things. Once you purchase it and log on to our website, you automatically receive any updates or new footnotes I add.

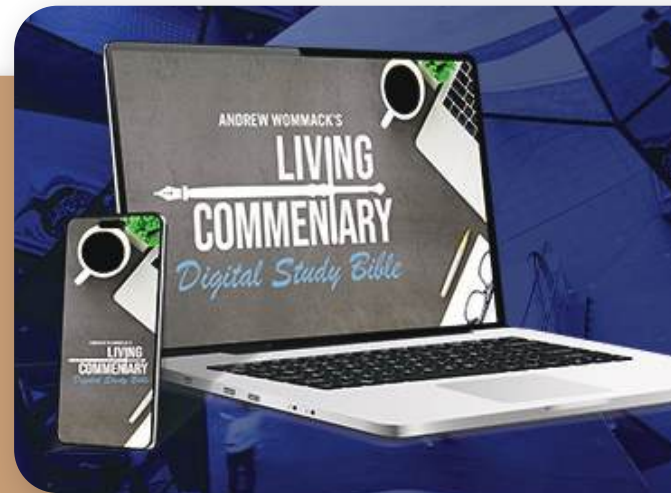
You can also add your own notes to record what God is teaching you, access other respected commentaries like *Adam Clarke's Commentary on the Bible*, *Albert Barnes' Notes on the Whole Bible*,

and *Matthew Henry's Concise Commentary*, and view multiple translations side by side. Concordances, dictionaries, and a full atlas with biblical maps are also included so you can see where events took place, understand key words, and compare passages across Scripture. More than that, these features help you interact with God's Word, not just read it.

3 Ways To Give

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HARDNESS OF HEART

Have you ever stood in faith yet experienced the opposite of what you were believing for?

In *Hardness of Heart*, Andrew shares a story of a time he tried to pull a quadriplegic man out of a wheelchair. Prior to this, Andrew had seen someone raised from the dead and fully expected to see this man get up and walk. Instead, the man fell to the ground, and Andrew had to help him back into his wheelchair.

Confused, Andrew asked God, “What’s wrong? How come I’m not seeing Your healing power? I know it’s Your will to heal, and I know that I believe it—what am I missing?”

After meditating on this for some time, while flying over the Great Lakes, Andrew read a verse in Mark 6 that highlighted the disciples’ response to Jesus walking on the water—and it changed everything:

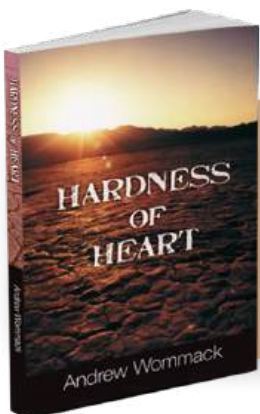
*And [Jesus] went up unto them into the ship; and the wind ceased: and **they were sore amazed in themselves beyond measure, and wondered.***

Mark 6:51, brackets and emphasis added

Looking out the window at the clouds beneath the wing of the plane, Andrew imagined Jesus walking on them—something just as miraculous as Him walking on water. And like the disciples, Andrew found himself sore amazed, and he thought that this was a good thing. Then he read the next verse, verse 52:

*For they considered not the miracle of the loaves: **for their heart was hardened.***

Andrew suddenly understood: just like the disciples, he had been amazed because he had a hardened heart.

A hardened heart isn't only about living in sin or total rebellion against God. It's also about being more sensitive to—or more focused on—the natural realm than on the supernatural realm. Andrew realized that his own hardness of heart had kept him from seeing more of God's supernatural power in his life.

And if we're honest, all of us have hardened hearts to some extent—hearts that aren't as sensitive and attuned to God as they should be. Our hearts become sensitive to what we focus on and hardened toward what we neglect.

The key is choosing to trust God by keeping our minds stayed (focused) on Him:

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Isaiah 26:3

When we do this, we'll begin to see more of the supernatural power of God in our everyday lives. ♦

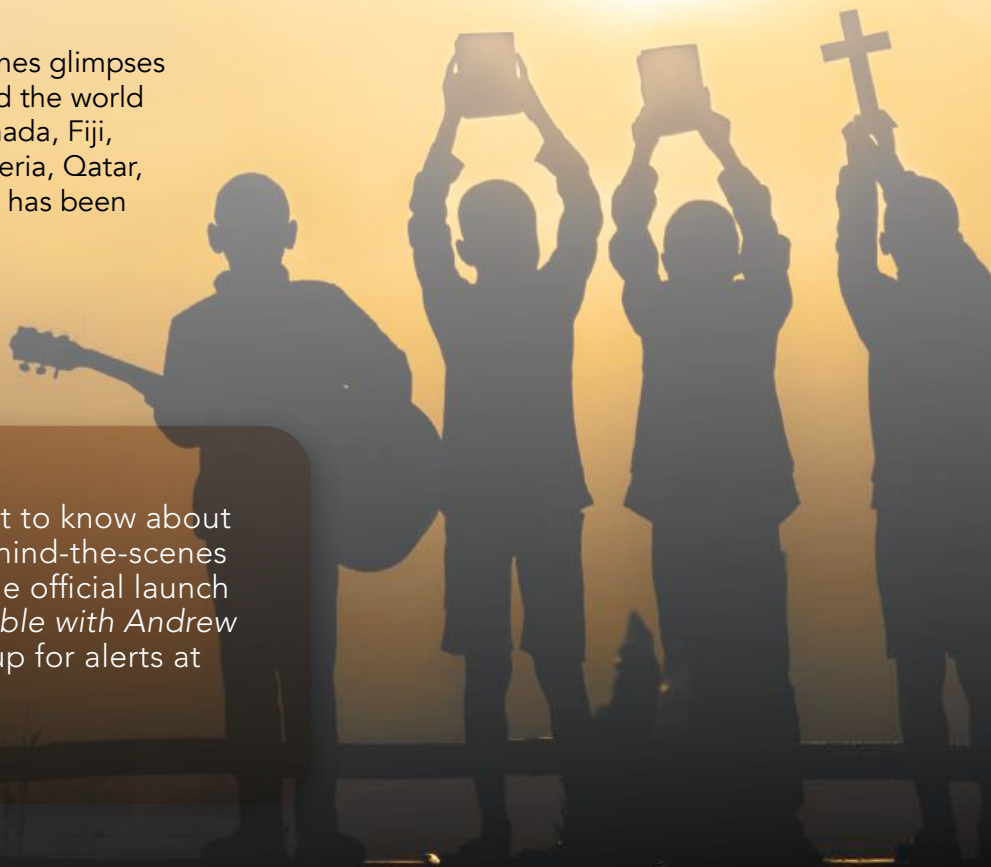

FAITH WINS: DOROTHEA'S HEALING VICTORY

What if the one thing standing between you and your healing is knowing the truth about what God promises in His Word? Dorothea from Germany could never have anticipated how life-changing her decision to attend Charis Bible College would be. After a friend introduced her to Andrew Wommack's teaching, Dorothea made plans to attend Charis in Frankfurt, Germany.

Just days before classes began, Dorothea received devastating news: malignant melanoma—a dangerous form of skin cancer—had been found on her knee. But instead of shrinking back, she chose to hold fast to God's Word. "I wanted to build up my faith," she said, "because the Lord promised that my faith makes me whole. I clung to that word."

As she leaned into the Word through her classes, Dorothea's faith grew stronger. For her, that meant taking a firm stand on God's promises: "I decided not to take any treatment. My faith was getting so strong the more and more I was listening to Andrew's messages, and I was sure I was healed."

During her time at Charis, Dorothea experienced complete healing. She saw the mountain of cancer bow before the Word of God—just as Jesus said in Mark 11:23, *"For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith."*

Now, more than a decade later, Dorothea not only continues to walk in total health but also helps others discover the same faith in Christ. Serving at Charis Frankfurt, she says, "You hear the students' stories, and you can pray for them. You can recommend books, to read this or listen to that, and they are so happy. This



ministry is really a blessing for Germany, and we expect great, great things in Europe and in the whole world."

Dorothea's testimony is a powerful reminder that God's promises are real, His Word is true, and His healing power is available today.

Head knowledge of God's Word is like holding a key in your hand—but heart knowledge is what turns that key and opens the door to healing and victory. At Charis, Dorothea learned how to unlock that door and walk fully in the healing God provided. ♦
